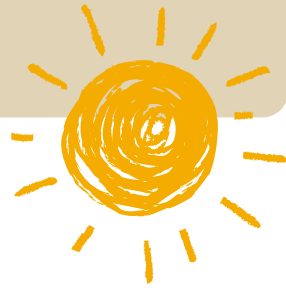
SUMMER HOLIDAY HOMEWORK

Homework Activities

(To be submitted after the break)

1. MY COLOUR BOOK

Instructions

- Use any small notebook or staple 6 -8 blank pages to make your child's Colour Book.
- Dedicate each page to one colour - Red, Yellow, Blue, Green, Orange and Pink.
- On each page, stick, or draw objects of that colour.
Example:
Red Page - Tomato, Apple
Yellow Page - Sun, Banana
- Encourage the child to say the colour name and object while pasting.

2. LEAF JOURNAL - MY NATURE BOOK

Instructions

- Collect different types of leaves from the garden, park or during walks.
- Stick one leaf per page in a simple handmade "Leaf Journal".
- Feel the texture, look at the shape and colour of each leaf.

3. THE MASALA DIARY

Instructions

- Begin by gathering a variety of spices commonly used in your kitchen.
- Choose spices with distinct aromas and flavours to provide a rich sensory experience for your child.
- You can include spices such as cinnamon, cumin, turmeric, paprika, cloves, cardamom etc.
- Once you've explored the spices, help your child place a small amount of each spice into individual ziplock bags.
- Ensure that each ziplock bag is labeled with the name of the spice using a marker or pen.
- Take a scrapbook or notebook and title it "The Masala Diary". On each page of the scrapbook, glue or adhere one of the ziplock bags containing a spice.
- Encourage your child to decorate the pages of the scrapbook with drawings, doodles or stickers related to spices and cooking.



4. FAMILY HANDPRINT ART

Instructions

- Use washable paints to make handprints of each family member on a big sheet.
- Label each handprint with person's name.
- Title it "My Lovely Family".

5. SORTING BY SIZE

Instructions

- Collect objects of different sizes (small, medium, big).
- Ask your child to arrange them from small to big.
- Let them name the size too.

At - Home Play Ideas

1. SOUND GAME (SENSORY DEVELOPMENT)

Instructions

- Make different sounds (clap, tap, ring, a bell etc.)
- Ask your child identify or copy the sound.
- Take turns and make it a fun game.

2. MATCH THE PAIR GAME (COGNITIVE SKILLS)

Instructions

- Collect simple pairs (socks, spoons, toys etc.)
- Mix them and ask your child to find matching pairs.
- Encourage them to say what they matched.

3. ANIMAL WALK RACES (GROSS MOTOR SKILLS)

Instructions

- Teach your child to move like different animals.
 - Hop like a frog.
 - Waddle like a duck.
 - Crawl like a bear.
 - Slither like a snake.
- Create a start and finish line and have fun races using animals movement.
- Praise your child's efforts and encourage imaginative movement!

4. CLOTH PEG ACTIVITY (FINE MOTOR SKILLS)

Instructions

- Give your child cloth pegs and a box or paper.
- Ask them to clip pegs on the edge.
- Let them use fingers to press and release.
