- With the help of your parents, find and collect interesting words from:

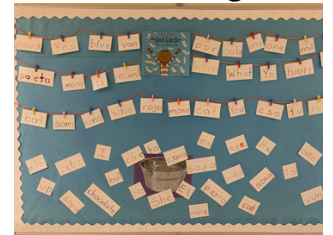
Old books

9. INSPIRING PERSONALITIES

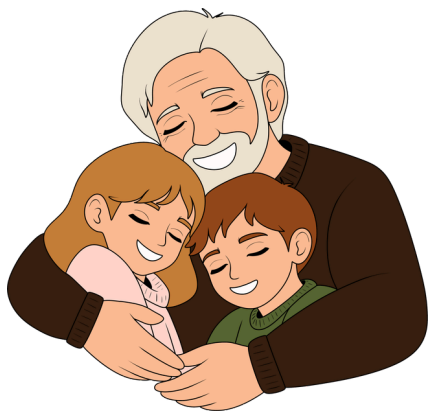
Instructions
