What to do: Start a 28 days moon watch.

How to do it: Every night before bed, look at the sky and draw the shape of the Moon you see in your journal. If it’s cloudy, research if the Moon is hiding or if it is the “New Moon” phase.

Observe and trace: Look at your drawings from Day 1 to Day 14. Observe the lighted part of the Moon. Is it growing bigger or getting smaller as the days pass?
