Instructions:

- Choose a place you visited or want to visit.
- Fold the A4 sheet like a brochure (2 or 3 folds).

Include:

- Name of the place
- 4–5 lines about it
- Why people should visit
- Draw or paste pictures

Example ideas:

- Beach
- Hill station
- Zoo
- Park

Extra: Use attractive headings like:

❖ ACTIVITY 4: SCIENCE

Select any one Activity and complete it creatively on A4 sheet.

Create a Habitat Model in a Box:

Choose one habitat from below:

- forest
- desert
- ocean
- grassland

📦 Instructions:

Take a shoe box or any small box.

Decorate it to show your chosen habitat.

Use clay, paper, colours, sand, leaves, cotton, etc.

Add: plants, animals, natural features (water, sand, mountains, trees)

After making the model, write the answers of the following questions on a A4 sheet:

Title: My Habitat Model – (Name of Habitat)

Q1. Where is it found on Earth?

Q2. What is the climate of the habitat? (hot/cold/wet/dry)

Q3. Name the types of plants and animals found there.

OR

The Sustainable Artist (Recycling)

Objective: To practice sustainability by recycling household waste into art.

What to do: Create handmade paper from old newspapers.

How to do it:

Paper Making: Soak newspaper scraps in water overnight, blend into a pulp, spread it flat on a mesh or cloth and let it dry.

Perform the activity and create your gratitude Journal:

- Decorate pages with drawings or borders. Write short sentences about what you are grateful for.....
- Bind your journal – Arrange all the pages together – tie them neatly using a ribbon
- Give your journal a creative name.
e.g. “My Little Books of Thanks”

❖ **ACTIVITY 5: SOCIAL SCIENCE**

Select any one Activity and complete it creatively on A4 sheet.

The “Physical Map” model:

Build a 3D map of India on a cardboard base or old tray

- Green clay: The plain
- Brown clay: The plateau
