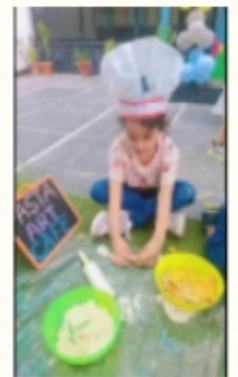
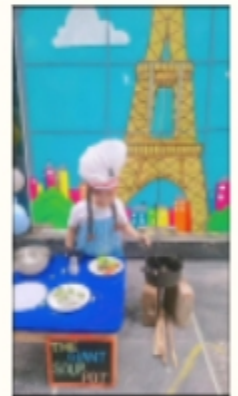


Welcome Back to School – A Ratatouille-Themed Celebration!

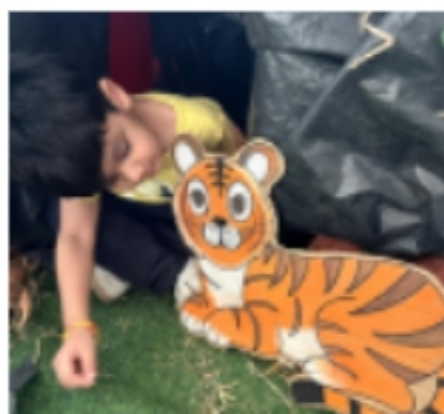
