



Inter-House Maths Quiz Balsabha Competition – “Mind Marathon”

REPORT

Event: *Mind Marathon – Inter-House Mathematics Quiz Competition*

Date: 13th November 2025

Venue: MP Hall

Classes Involved: VI to IX

Participants: 8 students from each House (2 students from each class)

Objective:

The “Mind Marathon” was organized to enhance mathematical aptitude, logical reasoning, and problem-solving skills among students. It aimed to encourage teamwork and healthy competition between the four school houses.

Structure of the Competition:

The quiz comprised **four engaging rounds** designed to test different aspects of mathematical understanding:

1. Round 1 – Conceptual Round

- Focus: Basic mathematical concepts and logical reasoning.
- Time: 30 seconds per question.
- Marks: 2 marks for each correct answer.
- No negative marking.

2. Round 2 – Visual View Round

- Focus: Identify patterns, figures, and mathematical visuals.
- Time: 30 seconds per question.
- Marks: 2 marks per correct answer.
- No negative marking.

3. Round 3 – Riddle Round

- Focus: Mathematical riddles testing creativity and reasoning.
- Time: 1 minute per riddle.
- Marks: 2 marks for each correct answer.
- No negative marking.

4. Round 4 – Rapid Fire Round

- Focus: Speed and accuracy in solving quick math questions.
- Time: 1 minute per set of 10 questions.
- Marks: 2 marks per correct answer.
- No negative marking.

Participation:

Each house was represented by **8 participants** (2 from each class VI–IX). The competition was conducted under the supervision of the Mathematics Department, with Ms Sweeksha ,Ms Ashu and Ms Tarika acting as quizmasters and scorers.
