FIRE SAFETY WORKSHOP





On April 18, 2024, Delhi Public School conducted a fire safety awareness workshop to enhance students' and staff's knowledge and skills in preventing and responding to fire emergencies. The session began with a tribute to Mumbai's fallen heroes, highlighting fire safety's critical importance. Fire safety experts presented on the conditions for fire (fuel, air, and heat) and categorized fire types (Class A, B, C, and D). They demonstrated safe evacuation techniques, such as crawling to avoid smoke. The workshop covered three primary fire extinguishing methods: Cooling, Smothering, and Starving, with practical examples. Participants learned about fire extinguisher composition and use. The session ended with a Q&A, reinforcing fire safety protocols.

WATER PLEDGE

In an effort to raise awareness about water conservation, students and teachers at DPS Ludhiana took a Water Pledge on May 6, 2024. Emphasizing the vital role of water in all living organisms, everyone committed to conserving every drop and promoting water management practices to minimize wastage and maximize beneficial uses.






PARENTAL WORKSHOP - MATHEMATICS

In today's rapidly changing world, it is crucial that children develop critical thinking skills and the ability to apply their theoretical knowledge in real-life situations. With this in mind, Delhi Public School, Ludhiana organized a Mathematics Parental Workshop for the parents of Class IV students. The workshop, led by Ms. Rajneesh Dhillon, aimed to share the teaching and learning practices used in the classroom with the parents.
