Prayagraj sits at the Triveni Sangam, where the Ganga, Yamuna, and the unseen Saraswati converge. It is a city built around meeting rather than division, a place where different currents arrive together and become something larger. There are few better settings for a conference built on dialogue.

That belief took shape gradually. In 2025, a group of students at DPS Prayagraj started Diplosphere, the city's first MUN club — a handful of delegates meeting after school hours, slowly building something none of them had quite pictured yet. In May 2026, that work found its first real form in the DPS Colloquium, an intra-school Model UN conference. It was modest, but it gave every student, regardless of experience, a chance to step into the shoes of global leaders, learn procedure, and find their voice in a room. It also confirmed something: Prayagraj was ready for more.

DPSAMUN 2026 is that next step — the Diplosphere Club's first inter-school conference, bringing together delegates from schools across the region and beyond. Spanning nine committees, from the political weight of the AIPPM and the historical crises of the Emergency of 1975 and the Unification of Germany, to live debates in the UNSC, UNHRC, IAEA, and UNGA ECOFIN, to the storytelling of our International Press corps and the unpredictability of the Ad-Hoc Committee — this conference has been built with the same care and conviction that started it all.

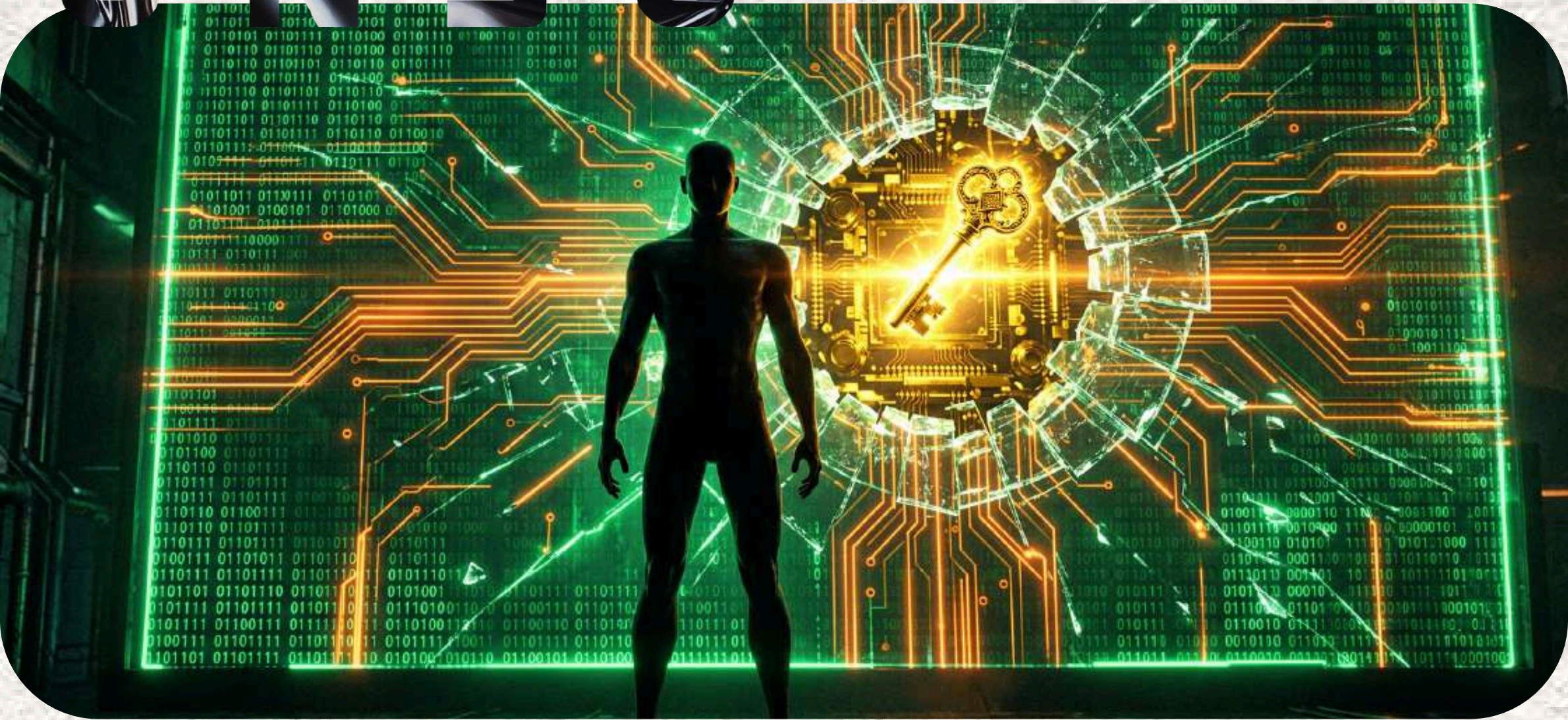

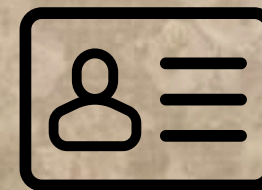
