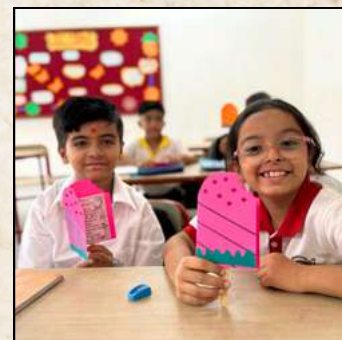

The assembly was a reflection of informed, empathetic, and empowered young minds—ready to lead change.



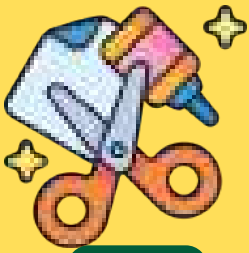
Exploring Talents Beyond the Classroom – Club Activities
