Greetings!!

This is to inform you that the **Cambridge English Assessment Examination will be conducted on 11th March (Wednesday), 12th March (Thursday) and 13th March (Friday). The exam will be conducted (only for Cambridge-enrolled students) during regular school hours, i.e. 8.00 am to 2.00 pm.**

The student will be assessed based on the Cambridge English pointers. Students will be given a mock practice for the same before the exam.

Kindly Note:

- The candidates need to carry their CoE and Aadhaar Card on the days of the examinations. **The CoE/Hall Ticket for the exam will be handed over to the students soon.**
- Stationery and other items for the exam:
 - For YLE Exams: Pencils, Eraser, Sharpener, Basic set of 12 colours only
 - (Crayon or Pencil Colours – No Sketch pens)
 - For A2 Key Exams: Pencils, Eraser, Sharpener.
 - For B1 Preliminary and B2 First: Pencils, Eraser, Sharpener, Blue ink Ball Point Pens.
 - For B2 First: Carry their own Wired Headphone/Earphone.
- Writing pads, Wrist Watches (smart/analog), and electronics are strictly not allowed in the examination hall.
- Candidates must carry their stationery in clear plastic pouches. (Cartoon boxes or fancy boxes are not allowed)
- Water may be carried only in clear, fully transparent plastic bottles. No metal bottles or non-transparent bottles can be brought into the exam hall.
- Candidates will have to leave all their belongings in the waiting room.
- Transport facilities will be provided to those availing of school transport. Students coming by private vehicle shall make their own arrangements.
- Students should bring a water bottle and a tiffin box with them, as no canteen facility will be available.
- **Kindly ensure your ward is present on the exam dates, as these exams cannot be rescheduled.**
