Experiential learning gives the students a first-hand experience of the issues that are facing the planet. Students get a deep insight into the problems which in turn ignites the feeling in them to look for ways to counter it.

❖ Nature walks, and sensory play in sand and water bring the young students close to nature and help build connections with nature, living, and non-living things.

❖ Community outreach programs taken up by the students inculcate a sense of responsibility in them.

❖ Drives like Donate an occasion, Joy of Giving Week, share a Meal initiative and other such programs taken up by the schools regularly and for all levels involve the students actively and help them get a perspective on ecological, social, and economic issues which in turn builds empathy and responsibility in them.

**The potential barriers and challenges in creating a culture of sustainability within educational institutions, and how can these be**

**addressed to drive meaningful change.**

The barriers and challenges in creating a culture of sustainability within educational institutions could be the lack of a sense of ownership or an attitude of indifference among the staff and the students. This could be addressed by holding events and activities that schools can organize in groups involving both the students and teachers, that take up small projects within the institution and in the neighbourhood. Plantation drives, walkathon, cycle rally, walk for the environment, donate a sapling and more such events are of great importance for schools to build awareness of sustainable practices bringing about a meaningful change in the perspectives.

**How can educators inspire and empower students to become agents of change in their communities, fostering a sense of responsibility towards sustainable practices beyond their immediate educational setting?**

Our school has clubs under various heads - Nature club, Environment club, Heritage club, Photography club, etc. to name a few that have students as members with a teacher in charge. The teacher and the students work together and plan activities in school/neighbourhood for spreading

awareness in the community that fosters a sense of responsibility in the children.

Peer education programs like teaching the Shiksha Kendra students about making compost from banana peel, educating the girls about menstrual hygiene, and having a veggie garden at school and at home are some
