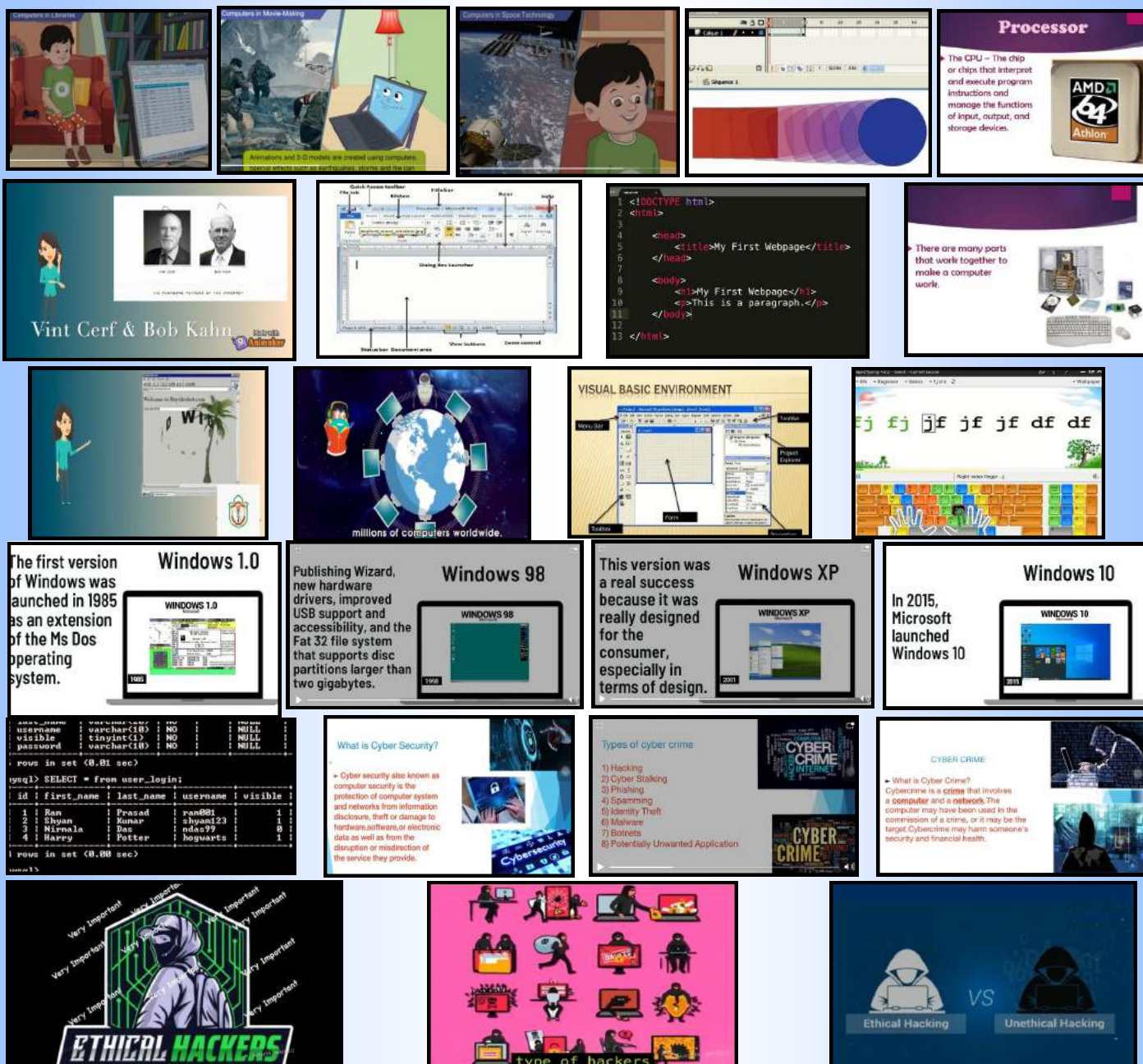

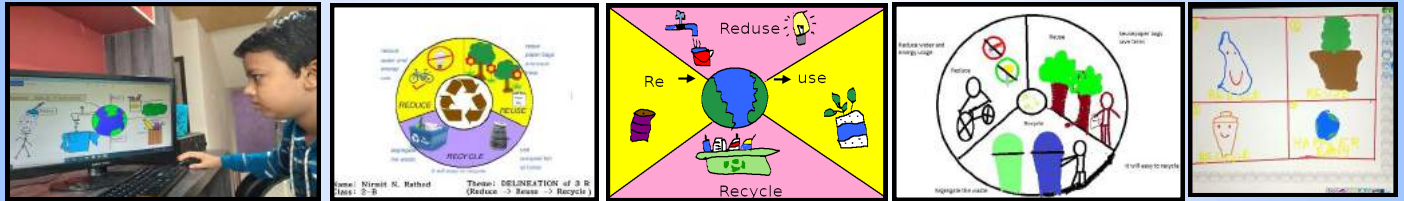

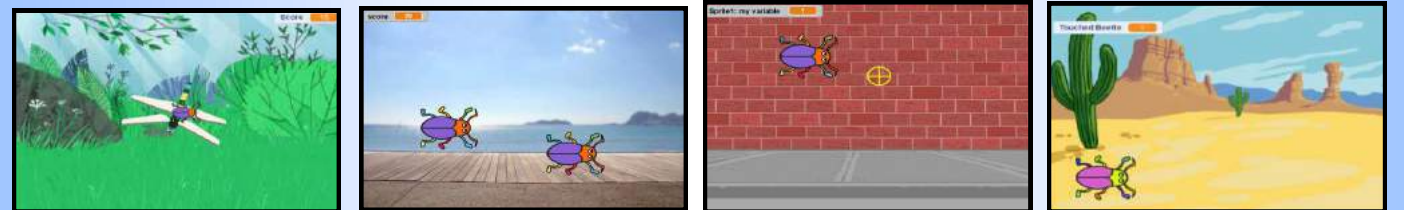

# SAHODAYA WORKSHOP

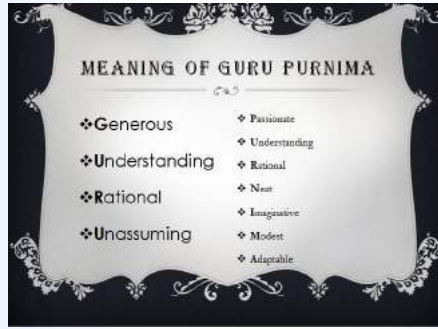

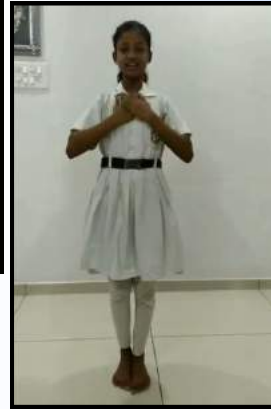
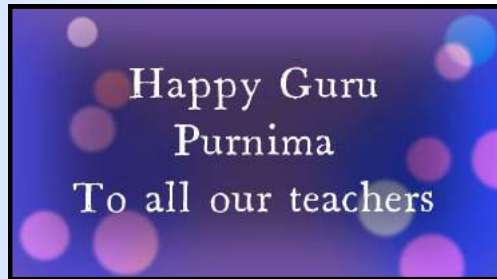

The clouds parted.

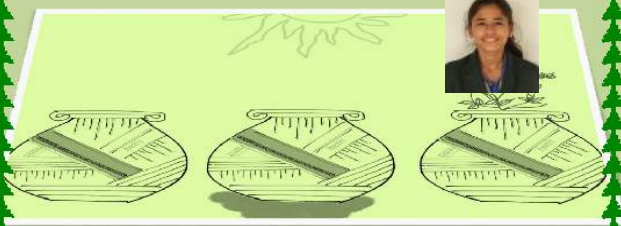
Upon us, an ethereal light shone

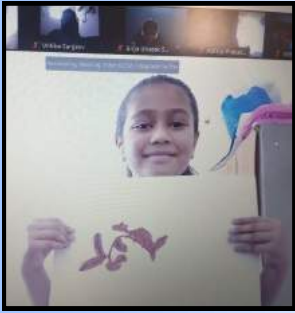


On campus Teaching for Class XII was resumed on 19th July 2021 as per Government's directives .

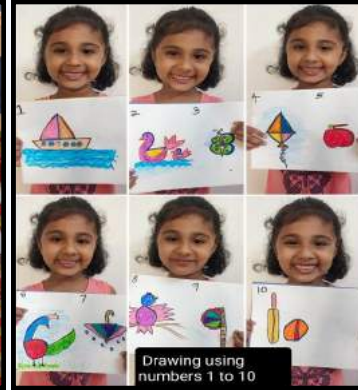

# FLIPPED CLASSROOM



A flipped classroom is a type of blended learning where students are introduced to content at home and practice working, through it at school. This is the reverse of the more common practice of introducing a new content at school, then assigning homework and projects to completed by the students independently at home.

The concept behind the flipped classroom is to rethink when students have access to the resources they need most. In this blended learning approach, face-to-face interaction is mixed with independent study—usually via technology. 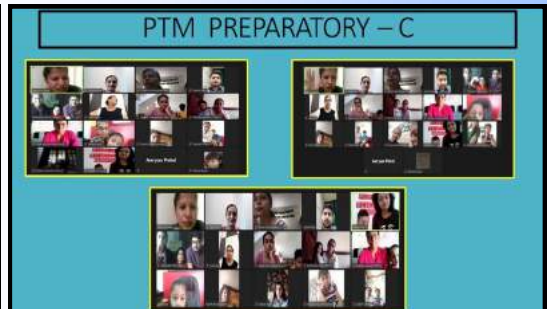

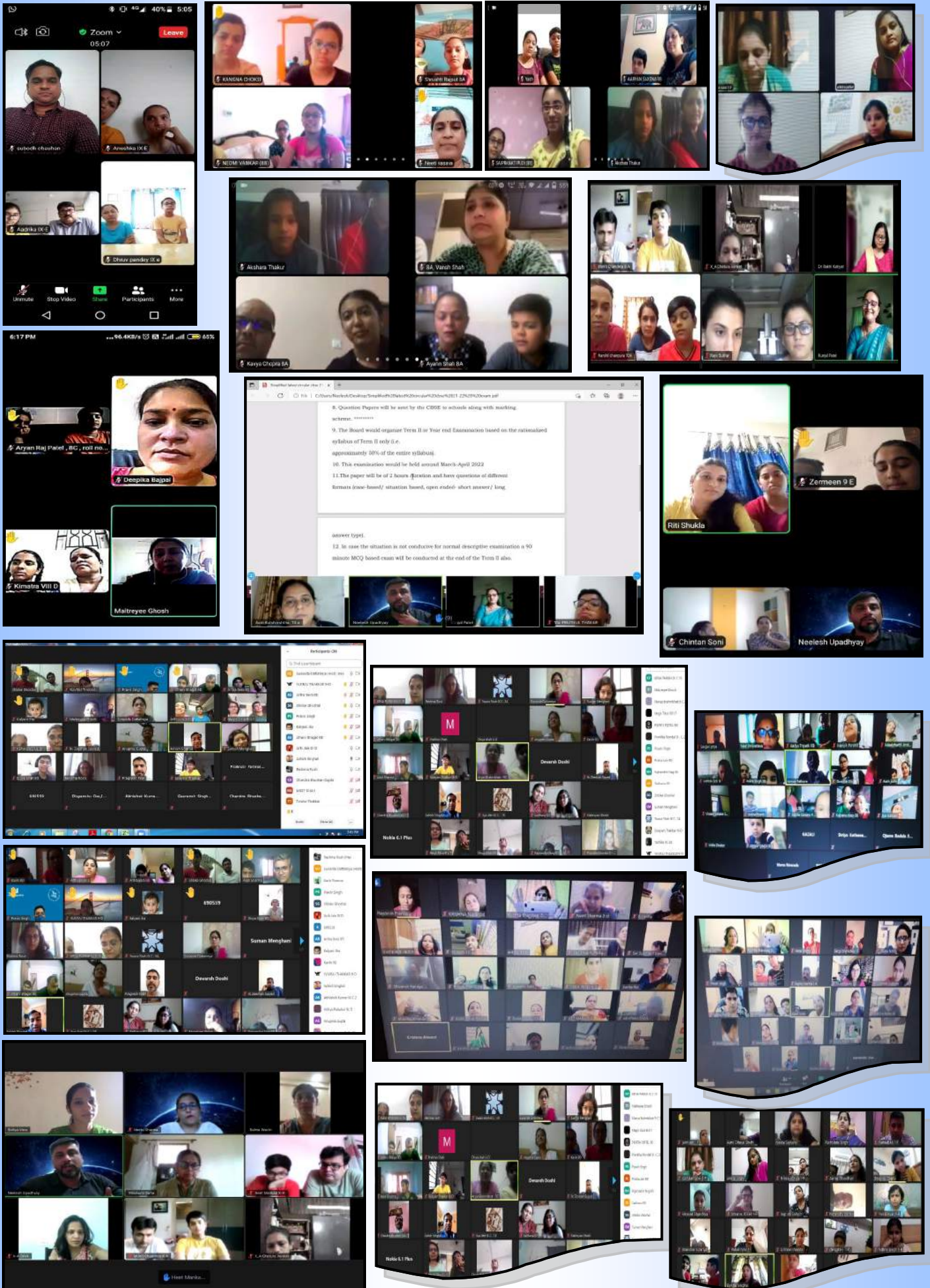
