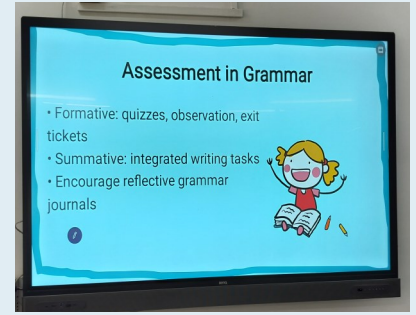
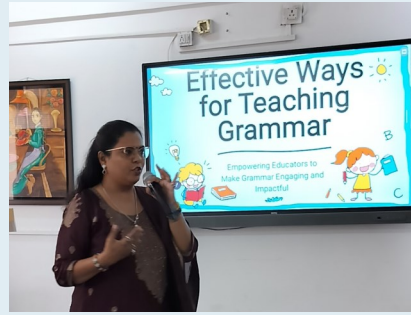

D.R.AMIN SCHOOL INTERSCHOOL COMPETITIONS

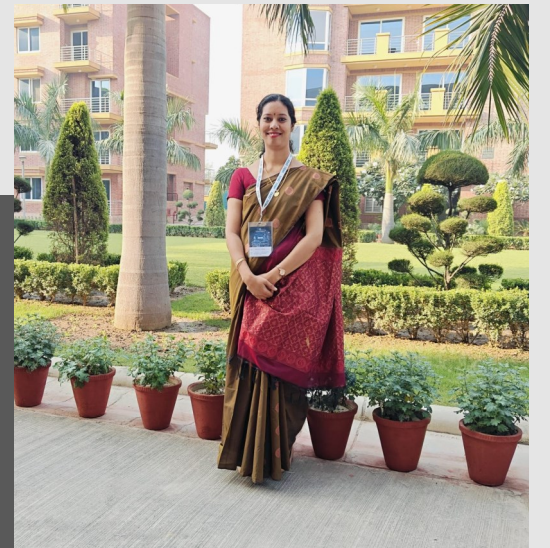

14 Schools participated from all over Vadodara.

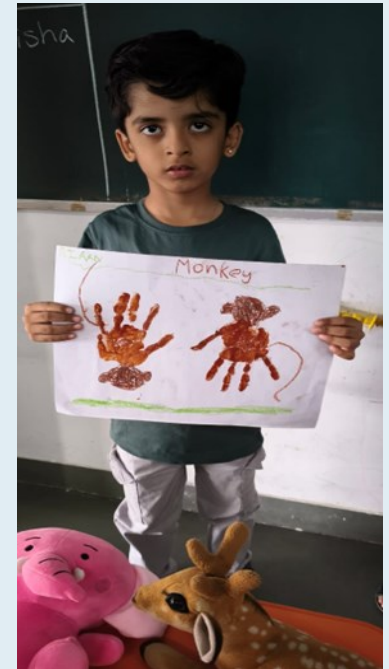

Zumba

Bubble Talk
