The celebration of the 79th Independence Day commenced on a beautiful note in Delhi Public School Harni on August 15, 2025. It was a red letter day in the history of India when the country got its freedom on August 15, 1947. It took hundreds of years for us to break the shackles of slavery. The celebrations on 15th August are a testimony to the hard work and efforts put in by our Brave Hearts who went through blood, sweat and tears to reclaim our independence.

The school was beautifully decorated with tricolor hangings created by the Art Department, enhancing the celebratory atmosphere. The festivities began with the ceremonial flag hoisting by the officiating Principal, Mr. Sanjay Kumar Singh followed by the National Anthem.

The cultural program showcased a variety of performances including a street play by the students of Primary section, a perfectly synchronized dance performance by the students of Secondary section, and a powerful speech on 'Independence Day' by a student of Class IX.

The audience's excitement was palpable throughout. Our Officiating Principal Mr. Sanjay Kumar Singh addressed the students and shared details about India's struggle for independence and freedom and urged them to keep the flag of the nation flying high as future citizens. The day fostered a sense of patriotism not just for today, but as a daily commitment.

Partition Horrors Remembrance Day 14th August

On 14 August 2025, Delhi Public School Harni observed Partition Horrors Remembrance Day, an event aimed at educating students about the significant historical events leading to India's Independence and traumatic partition that followed.

Short Video and Exhibition on Partition Horrors Remembrance Day

An exhibition and a short video were shown to the students which was about communal animosity and aggression. The anguish of homelessness and lack of shelter, the feeling of bereavement, coerced migrations, economic destitution, problems of uprooting and displacement as refugees.

Student Discussions and Reflections

Students analyzed the video shown to them and expressed their thoughts and formulated coherent responses. They were engaged in group discussions. Students expressed their views on the partition, its causes and its impact on the people of India and Pakistan.

Teacher-led Discussion

The event was further enriched by a discussion led by teachers who provided valuable insights into the historical context of the partition. They began by explaining the British strategy of 'Divide and Rule', religious extremism and the separatist politics of Indian leaders as factors that made the partition of India unavoidable. The Mountbatten Plan of 1947 which led to the partition of British India into two nations, India (Hindustan) and Pakistan. Teachers also emphasized these historical events in today's world and the importance of maintaining unity and communal harmony.





Partition Horrors Remembrance Day was a day of learning, reflection, and meaningful engagement with India's history. The active participation of students from all classes and insightful discussions led by teachers made the event memorable. Through these activities the school was able to commemorate a significant chapter in India's past but also instilled in the students a deeper understanding of the values of unity, peace and tolerance.

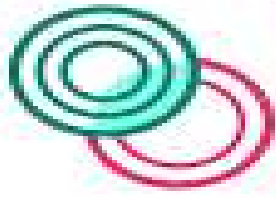


The highlight of the day was an insightful session by ATL Regional Mentor,

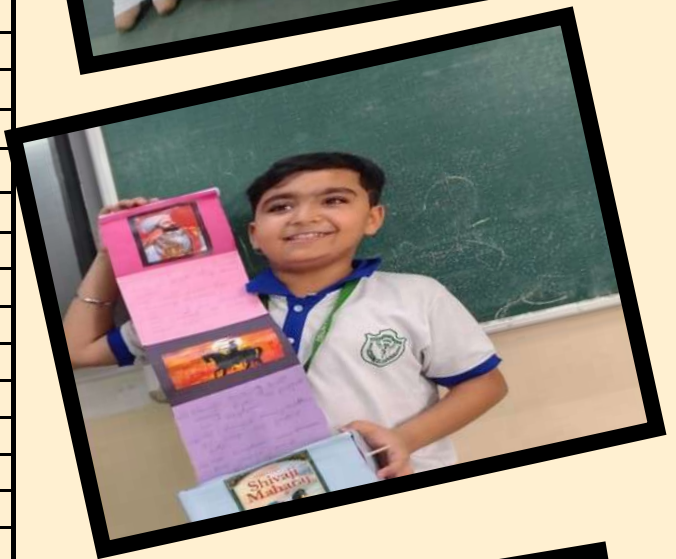

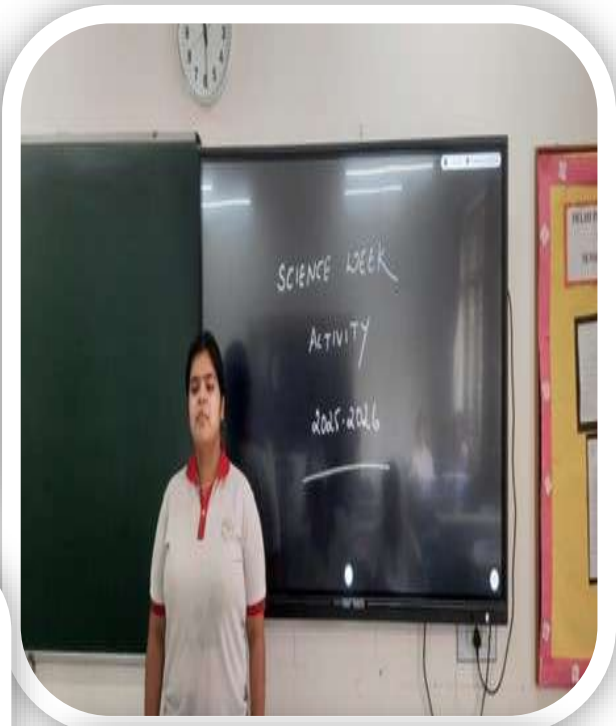

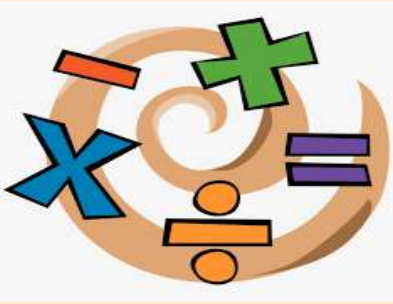
