



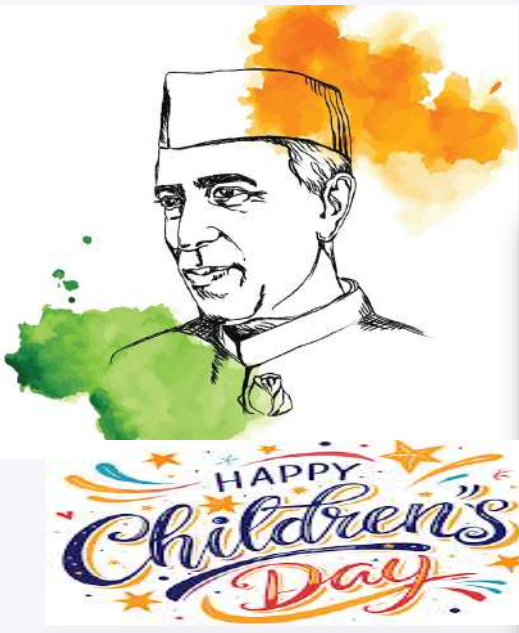

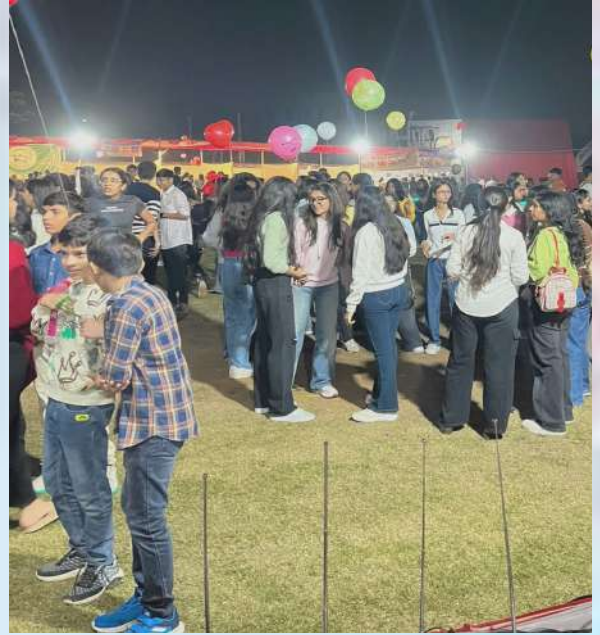
A rocking Jukebox played all the hits on demand, and the Fashion Fiesta ramp walk had the crowd cheering, giving students a major confidence boost.
