- * The day's event came to an end with the students delivering their vote of thanks and extending their warm regards to everyone present at the Annual Function.







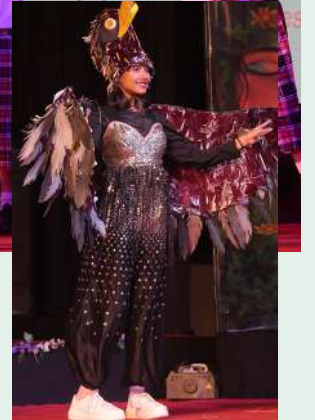
DAY 2

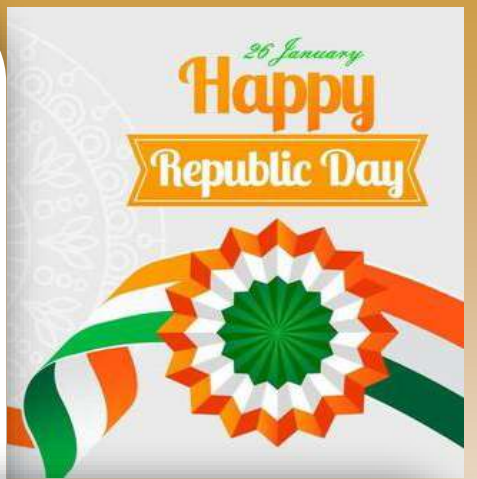
“Inspiring life of Queen Jind Kaur”
