# ORIENTATION PROGRAM

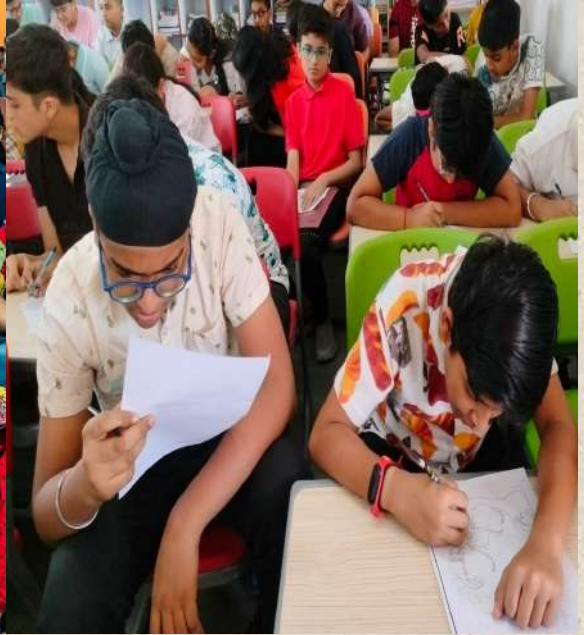
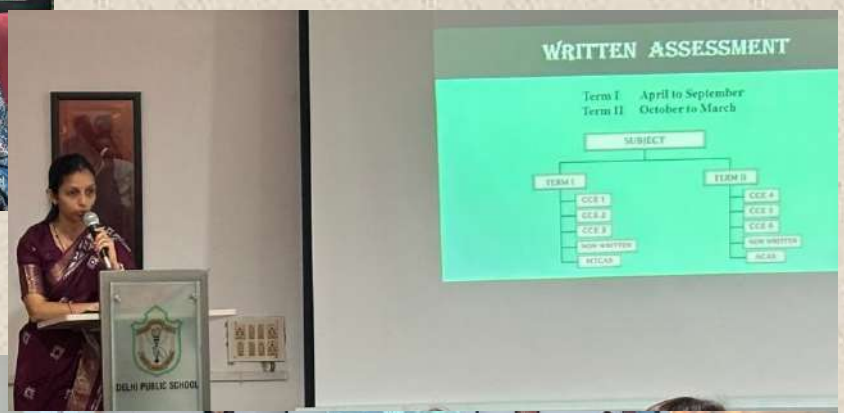


- An Orientation Program for the parents of Kindergarten students was organized to familiarize them with the school's curriculum, as well as its rules and regulations.
