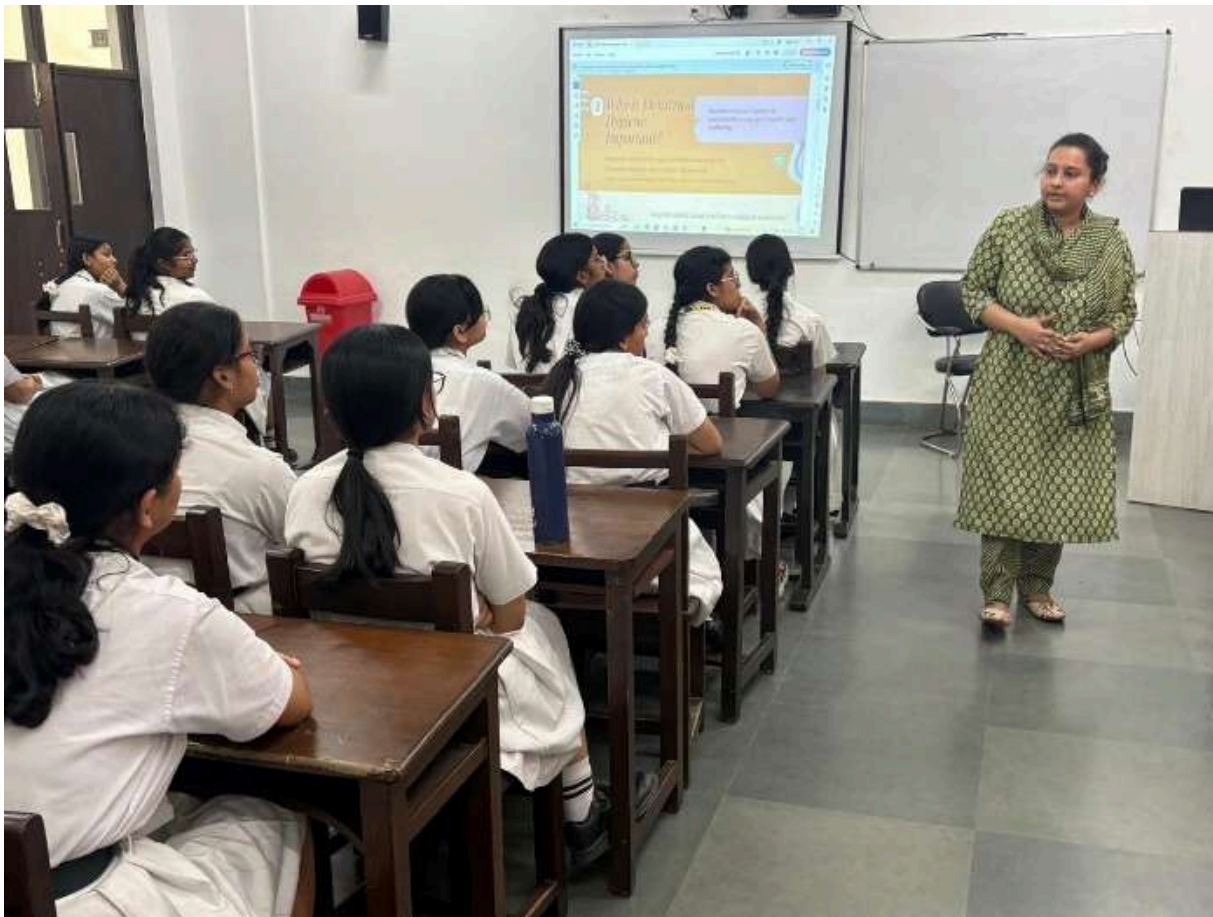
May 27, 2026

The session proved to be highly enriching and meaningful, reinforcing the school's commitment towards creating awareness, empowering young girls, and promoting holistic health and well-being among students.



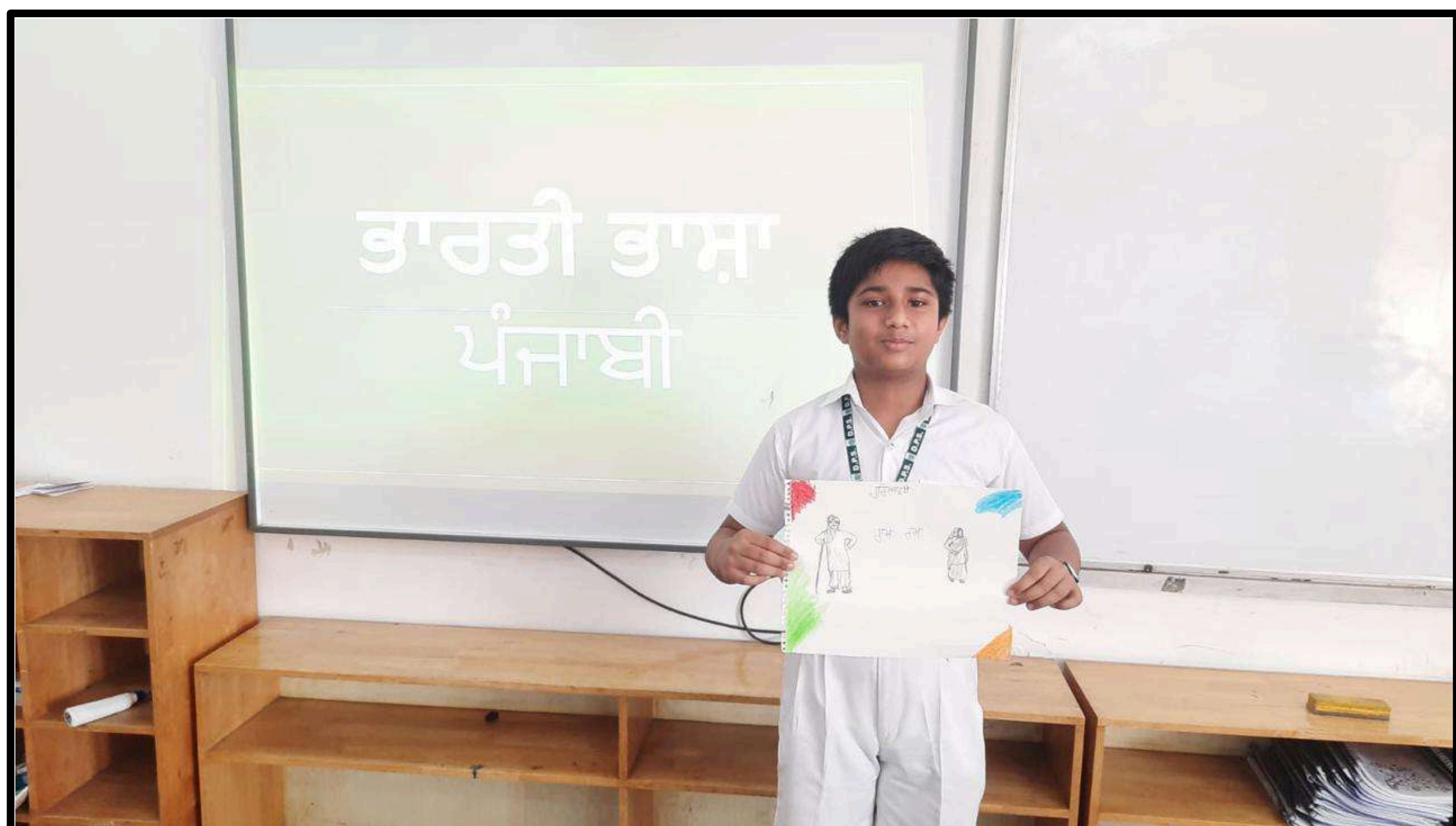
