# HEALTH AND HYGIENE AWARENESS WORKSHOP FOR GRADES V TO VIII





## FESTIVE FLAIR WITH FUTUREPRENEURS – TEEN TRADERS 3.0 FOR GRADE XI


Grade I & II students hopped onto the Metro, spreading excitement and awareness all around!



## LEARNING SESSION ON CONTINENTS AND OCEANS FOR GRADE V

Grade V students took the lead in a lively peer learning session on Continents and Oceans-learning by teaching, exploring, and discovering together.




Grade I learners grooved into math with the Tens and Ones Tango! Using blocks to build tens towers and hopping on number mats, they explored place value the fun, hands-on way!





# INSIDE THE HUMAN BODY: A HANDS-ON EXPLORATION FOR GRADE II




## PICK AND BUILD ACTIVITY FOR GRADE II

## MAGIC MATH MIX ACTIVITY FOR GRADE I



## ब) नैतिक व वैयक्तिक गुण\*:


1. \*प्रामाणिकपणा\* – तो खोटेपणा करत नाही, नकल करत नाही.





