



## WIZ INTERNATIONAL SPELLING BEE




## BOOK FAIR – OUR LITTLE READERS DIVED INTO A WORLD OF STORIES, FACTS, AND IMAGINATION

# GENSPHERE INSIGHT- CHARTING PATHWAYS TO THE CA PROFESSION





## SUGAR-FREE LIVING – A STEP TOWARD BETTER HEALTH – NO SUGAR AWARENESS SESSION



## LITTLE ORATORS OF GRADE III EXPLORING THE SEVEN WONDERS



Young scientists of Grade III, DPS MIHAN explored the states of matter during an exciting Matter Mission in the Composite Lab.



Through hands-on experiments, they observed changes from ice to water and water to steam, making science learning interactive and fun.

## HAPPINESS IN MOTION






## MASTERING TABLE ETIQUETTE – FINE SKILLS ACTIVITY




## WEAVE AND WONDER – THE MAGIC OF FABLES COMES ALIVE


## GRATITUDE IN LITTLE HANDS - THANKFULNESS CARD MAKING




# HOOPS OF GLORY- INTER-HOUSE BASKETBALL COMPETITION

Their performance highlighted strong pronunciation, devotion, and an admirable connection with the ancient verses.




The Inter-House Karate Competition for Class VI highlighted impressive discipline and technique.

Students showcased powerful moves and exceptional focus, making the event truly action-packed.







AI has stepped in at a time when both teachers and students needed such support, and it has become a valuable tool for them. The world needs AI greatly for the benefit of upcoming generations.



# RESILIENCE: THE MOST POWERFUL GIFT YOU CAN GIVE YOUR CHILD

As parents, we want to protect our children from pain and failure, but life will inevitably test them. In today's fast-paced world—filled with academic pressure, social media comparisons, and constant change—resilience is one of the most important skills a child can develop.

## 6 Simple Ways to Build Resilience:


- Let them struggle a little—problem-solving builds confidence.

Candles / Lights - Symbolize light removing darkness and bringing peace.


Santa Claus - Stands for kindness, sharing, and helping others.
