30TH JANUARY, 2026

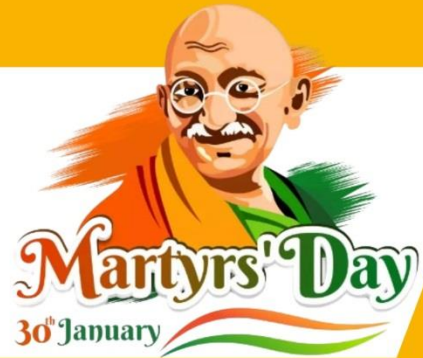
