Academic Year Structure

The academic session is divided into **two terms**:

- **Term I:** April – September
 - **Term II:** October – March
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NUR - UKG

- There is no formal term end examination for Nursery - UKG.
 - There is Comprehensive and Continuous evaluation based on observations, checklists and activities.
 - The focus is on understanding the child's overall growth and ensuring a nurturing and appropriate learning environment.
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CLASSES I TO II

- Formative System of Assessment will be applicable for these grades. Three formative Assessments would be conducted during the academic year.
- Students will be observed on a regular basis via conversations, projects C.W / H.W, visual testing, assignments, quizzes etc. so as to ensure continuous assessment.
- A Competency based Assessment will be conducted once in each term for Grade I and II .
- The report card will be continuous in nature wherein an educator uses a checklist to assess student's progress and provides feedback to both students and parents.
