Periodic Tests	Short written tests conducted in both terms
Multiple Assessments	Quiz, debate, role play, presentations
Portfolio	Classwork, homework, assignments
Subject Enrichment	Practical, project, speaking and listening activities

Listening	Classroom-based listening tasks
Speaking	Presentations, role play, interaction
Reading	Regular reading activities in class
Writing	Written examinations

Promotion Rules

A student is promoted if he or she: - Scores **33% or more in each subject** - Secures **33% overall** (Periodic Tests + Half-Yearly + Annual Examination) - Maintains **minimum 75% attendance** - Appears for and passes all practical and internal activities

Practical marks are mandatory to pass but are not added for promotion calculation.
