

The Annual Report of the Activities of St. Ignatius School, Aurangabad.

2025 – 2026

School Managing Committee Report as on 23.03.2025

- **New Academic Year:** The new academic session began on 01.04.2025 with assembly. Fr. Raj Kumar inaugurated the session. Mr. Ambuj, Mr. Alam and Mr. Serenus, the asst. teachers read the Holy verses from their Holy Books. The new students were welcomed by the Principal.
- **New Admission:** There were 1853 students in number. We had 348 new admissions in classes I to VIII.
- **Value education classes:** The school gives special emphasis on the formation of students. So along with extracurricular activities, the value education classes are also conducted. These values especially emphasis on the 4cs of Jesuit core values of competence, conscience, compassion and commitment. Besides these, the school organizes special curricular and co-curricular activities to promote the values enshrined in the Constitution of India.
- **Workshop by teachers:** All the teaching staff members attended 25 hours of online training workshops and in the month of January, 2025 the school conducted the 25 hours of In-House training for the staff. Thus, all the academic fraternity completed the required 50 hours of workshop each and the certificates were submitted to Regional Office, Patna. The faculty members had a day of workshop on 4th October, 2025 by Fr. Victor on the theme: “**Sarve Bhawantu Shukhina**”. It was very good workshop to make oneself and others happy.
- **Scholarship for Poor students:** There are 35 Maha Dalit students belonging to *Bhuiya* and other Dalit communities, who are freely educated by the school. Text books were freely given to 60 students.
- **Curricular activities:** The school gives equal weightage to the curricular and co-curricular activities. The school conducted a number of activities which would help the students to bring out their talents. Apart from the regular classes, we collect the assignments, note books and projects of students regularly to keep a check on their academic growth. The four Unit Tests were conducted and the half yearly and the annual exams were conducted smoothly.
- **Academic Excellence:** The performance of our class X students for the academic year 2024- 2025 was excellent. We got 98% result. Mrinal Ranjan obtained 97.2% marks and stood first in the school. Almost 14 of them secured more than 90% in their examination. There was a total of 169 students appeared for the CBSE Board Examination. We are very proud of our students.
- **Teaching Staff:** Many of the staff members got their jobs in the Government sectors and resigned from their post. Thus, we took a number of teachers. They are as follows: Sitesh

- **Co-Curricular Activities:** The school conducted a number of co-Curricular activities in the academic year 2025 – 2026. They are as follows:
- **English Elocution contest:** it was held online on 11th and 14th April, 2025 for the High and Primary School students. respectively.
