1. Vacancies exist in classes VI, VII, VIII, and XI (Science, Commerce and Humanities)
2. Online Registration starts from 18<sup>th</sup> February 2026 onwards.

5. Documents to be attached with the Admission Form at the time of admission
  - **Transfer Certificate (Original) and Character Certificate** (for classes XI – XII).
  - Attested photocopy of the Progress Card and a passport-size photograph.
  - For admission in class X/XII (subject to availability of seats), the original **Progress Card and Registration Card** of class IX/XI are to be attached. **Admission will be provisional until submission of the above documents.**
6. **Admission Procedure**
  - a) **Classes VI to VIII.** Students seeking admission in classes VI to VIII will be given a written test of the standard of the previous class, in the subjects as given below: -
    - Class VI: Hindi, English, Mathematics and EVS.
    - Class VII, VIII: Hindi, English, Mathematics, Science and Social Science.

### b) Class XI

**JBA students** will be considered provisionally promoted until the board declares their results.

The stream/subjects will be decided based on their cumulative performance in class X, as given below.

- A minimum of 60% marks in Maths and Science for PCM.
- A minimum of 50% marks in Maths and 60% in science in PCB.
- A minimum of 60% marks in Maths and for Commerce/Humanities with Maths.
- A minimum of 50% marks in Maths and for Commerce/Humanities with Economics.
- A minimum of 40% marks in Maths for Commerce without Mathematics/Humanities.

**Non-JBA students** will be provisionally admitted as per the merit list obtained through an entrance test as given below. Their stream and subjects will also be finalized after declaring their Board results, as per the criteria applicable to JBA students, given above.

- Science stream - English, Maths and Science
- Commerce/Humanities stream - English, Maths/Commerce/Soc. Sc. **(as per class X background)**

All class XI students (non-JBA) are to attend a compulsory Career Counseling Programme in April 2025.
