A PERSON WHO INSPIRES ME

Stephen Hawking

Inspiration is not just a feeling. It is a thought, a revolution, and hard work that makes a person truly worthy of it. For me, that person is Stephen Hawking. His extraordinary life, marked by incredible achievements and filled with many challenges, continues to inspire and motivate me.

Stephen Hawking was an English physicist, cosmologist, and one of the greatest theoretical scientists in the world. Stephen's father wanted him to become a doctor, but from a very young age, he had an interest in astronomy. At the age of 17, he got a scholarship to study at Oxford University. He completed his PhD in 1965 with breakthrough research.

He went to Moscow. There he came up with his theory of black holes. He became a Fellow of the Royal Society. Hawking received many significant awards, like the Eddington Medal, the Pius XI Gold Medal, and the Maxwell Prize. He became a professor and taught Gravitational Physics. Hawking was awarded the Albert Einstein Medal. He was also honored with a doctorate by the University of Oxford.

Hawking was counted as one of the most renowned cosmologists. He explained the creation of the universe and the Big Bang theory in his books.

He was only 21 when he was diagnosed with Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS). As his disease worsened, he began to trip, dropped items, and his speech became unclear. After a series of tests, doctors gave him only two and a half years to live. But he was young and ambitious, and the disease did not stop him from pursuing his dreams.

He became less mobile and began to use a wheelchair, but he still completed his PhD and released most of his major works.

In 2014, a movie based on Hawking's life was released called *The Theory of Everything*.

He died on March 14, 2018, but his work continues to inspire us to push boundaries and pursue our passions. His impact on science and humanity will be felt for generations to come.

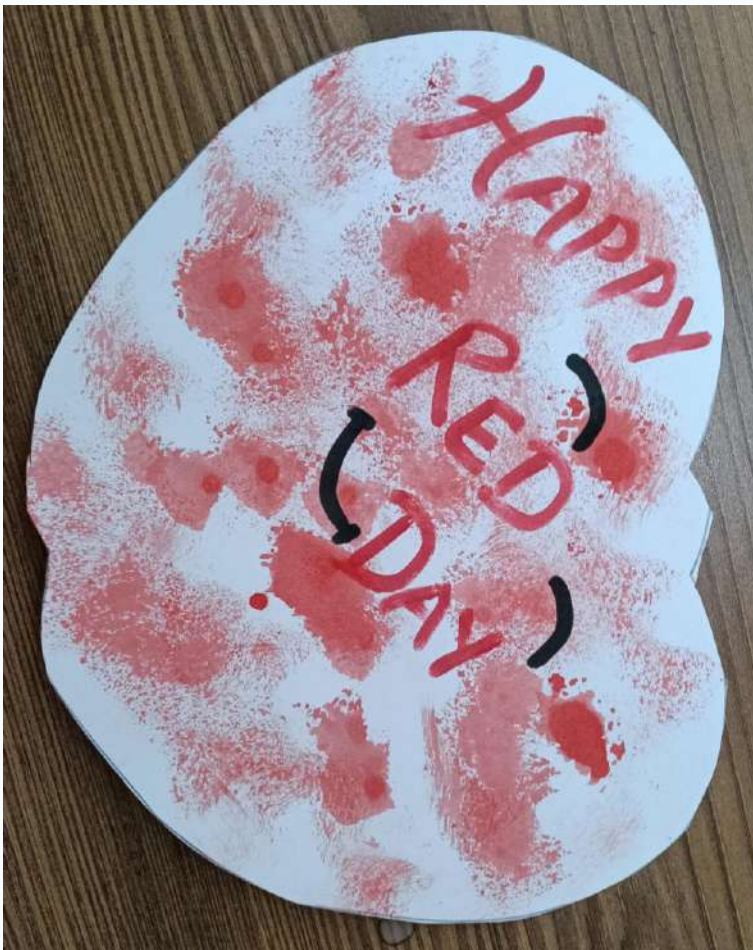

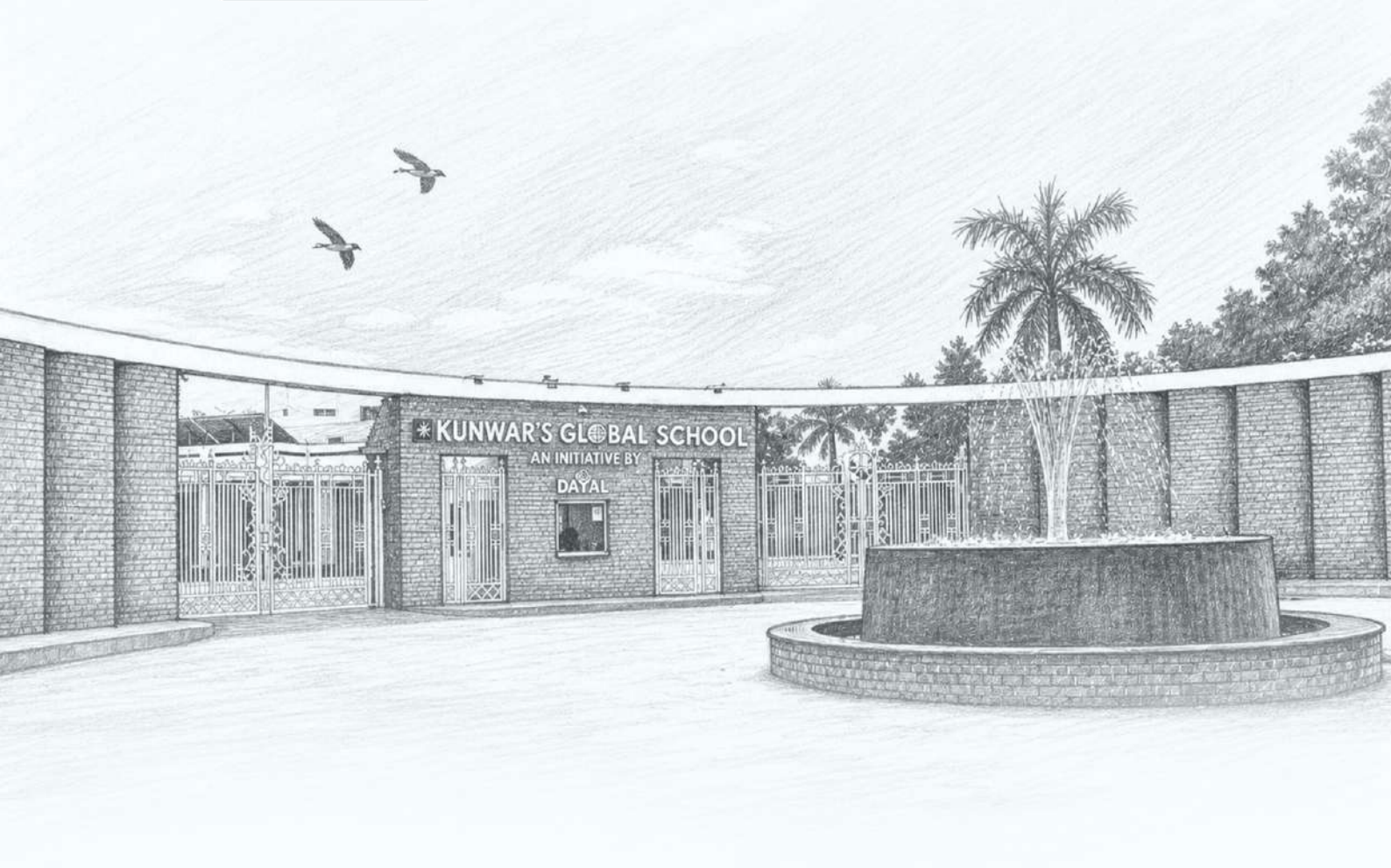
