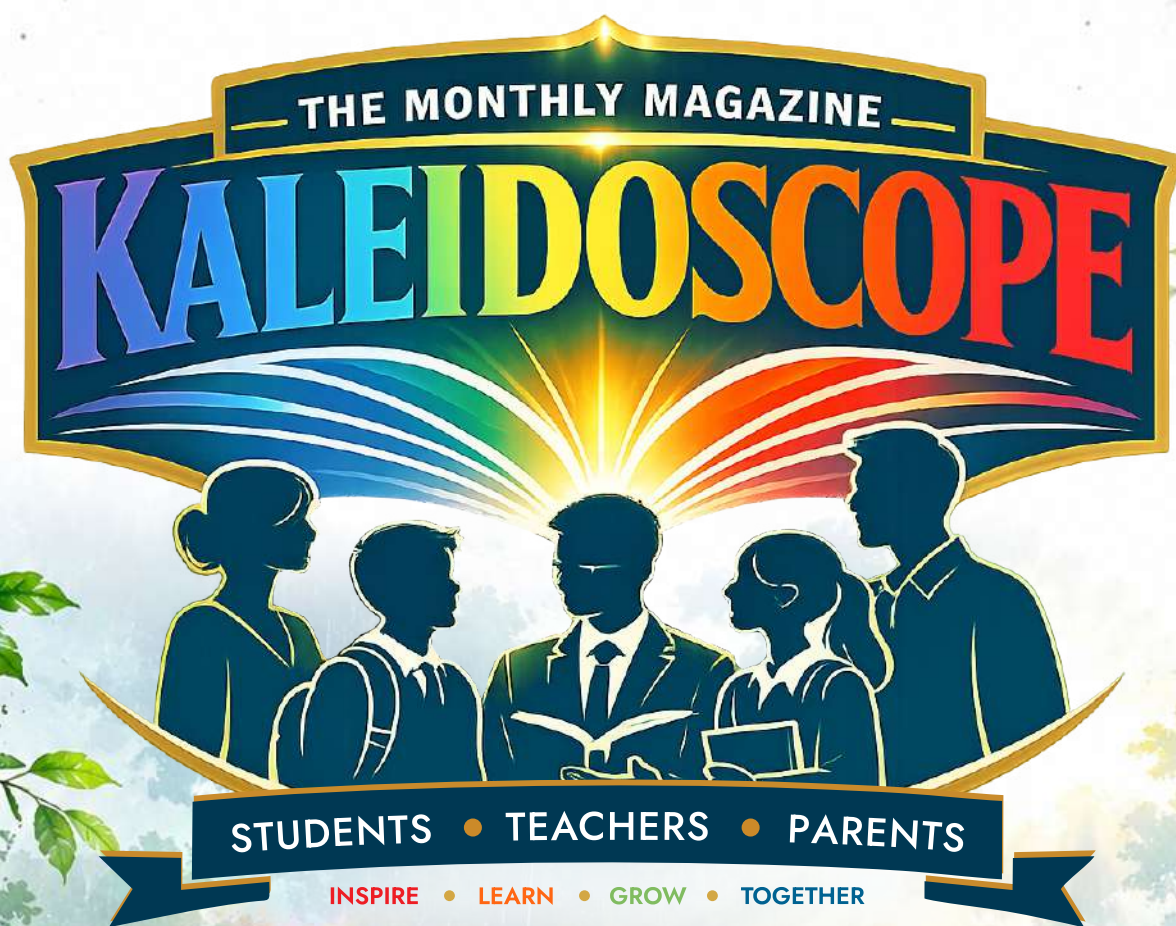

Objectives:

- To develop self-help and independent living skills.
- To learn the correct method of folding different types of clothes.
- To improve fine motor skills, concentration, and hand-eye coordination.
- To encourage cleanliness, organization, and responsibility for personal belongings.
- To build confidence in completing daily life tasks independently.

Learning Outcomes:

By the end of the activity, students were able to:

- Fold a shirt, pair of pants, handkerchief, and socks neatly.
- Organize their clothes in a systematic manner.
- Demonstrate responsibility towards personal belongings.

- Follow step-by-step instructions carefully.
- Appreciate the importance of cleanliness and tidiness.

Materials Required:

Each student brought:

- 1 Shirt (child-sized)
- 1 Pair of Pants (child-sized)
- 1 Handkerchief
- 1 Pair of Socks

Activity Plan:

- Introduction: Discussion on why folding clothes is an important life skill.
- Teacher demonstrated how to fold each item (shirt, pants, handkerchief, socks).
- Students practised folding their own clothes with teacher's guidance.
- Students arranged the folded



clothes neatly.

- Reflection and appreciation: Discussion on how this skill can help at home.

Teacher's Instructions:

- Demonstrated each folding step slowly.
- Encouraged students to refold if necessary.
- Appreciated every student's effort.
- Emphasized neatness, patience and care.

Assessment Criteria:

Students were assessed on:

- Correct folding technique
- Neatness of folded clothes

- Ability to follow instructions
- Independence while completing the task
- Care and organization of belongings

Values Integrated:

- Cleanliness
- Organization
- Respect for personal belongings

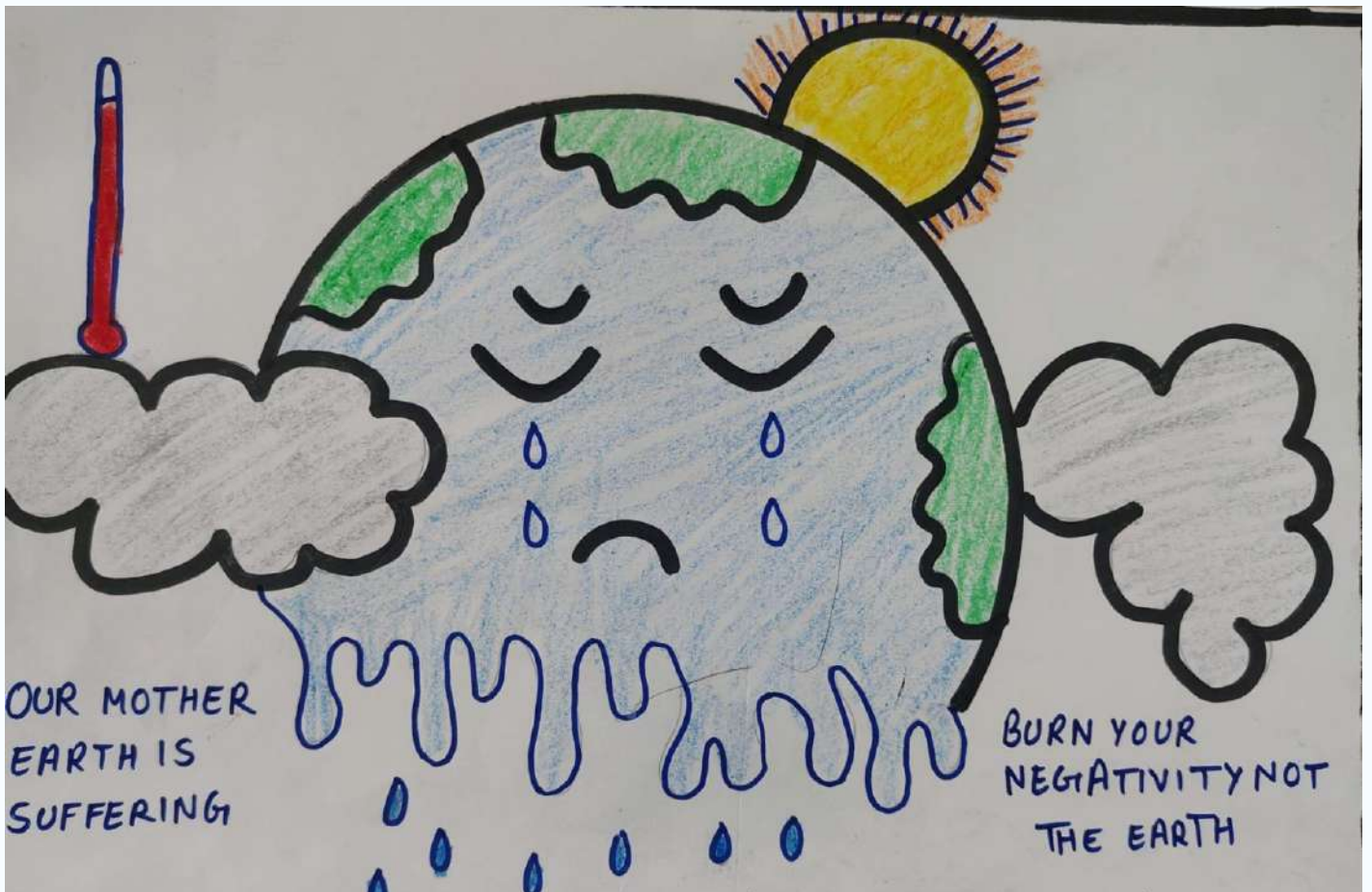

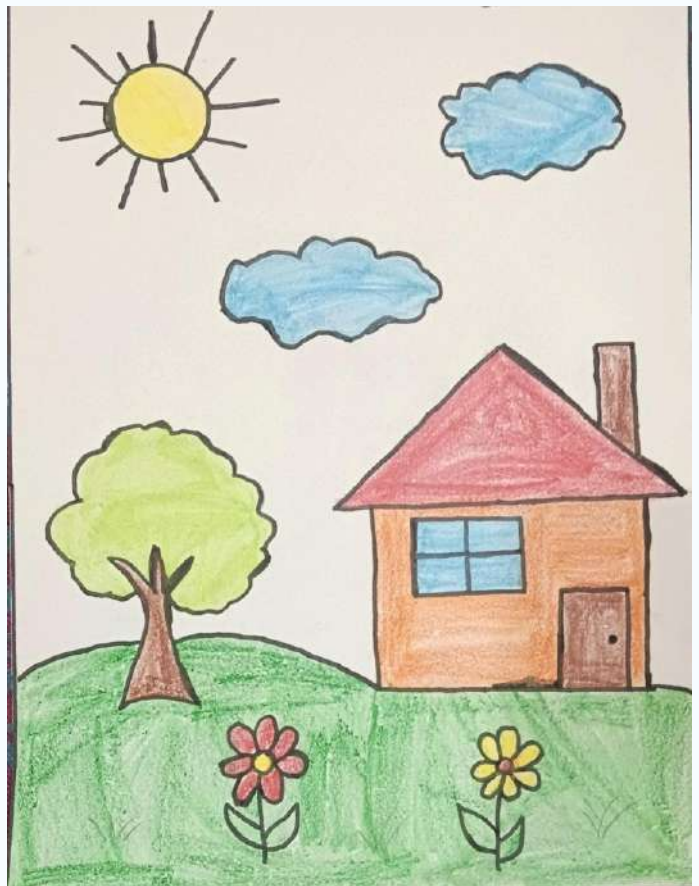

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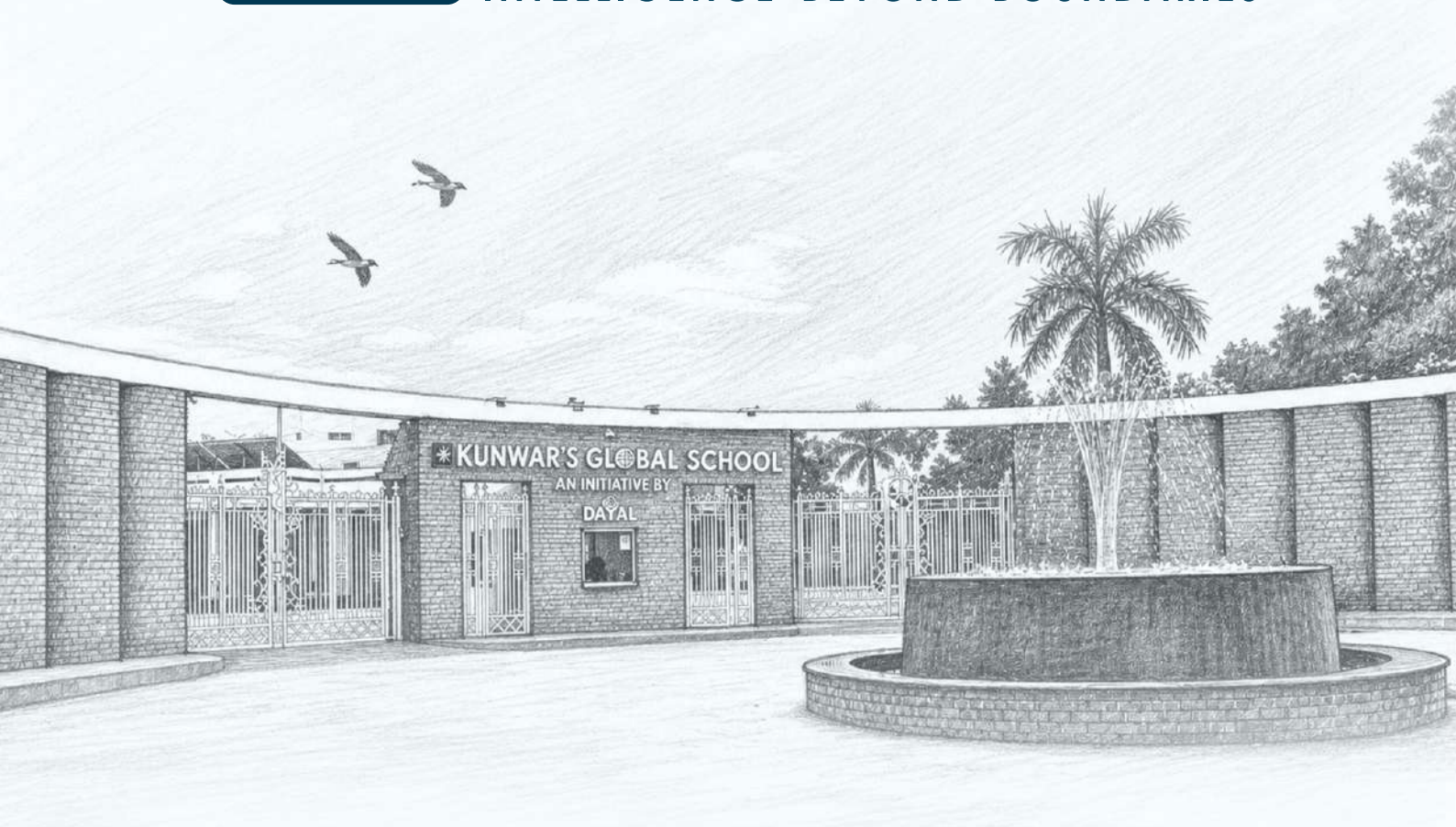
