Say NO to Dummy Admissions: A Wake-Up Call for Parents

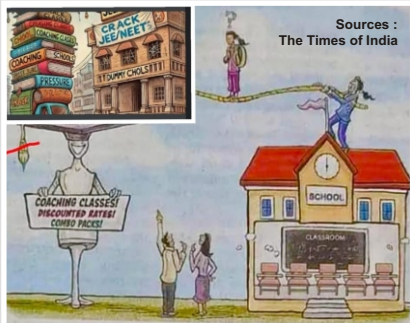

There's a basketball court on top of the U.S. Supreme Court! It's

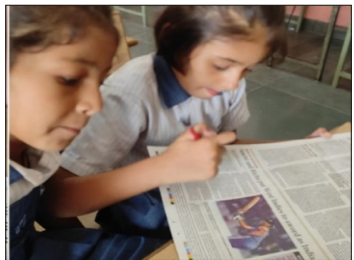
nicknamed the "highest court in the land."
