Fancy Dress Competition Brings Colour and Creativity to the Stage

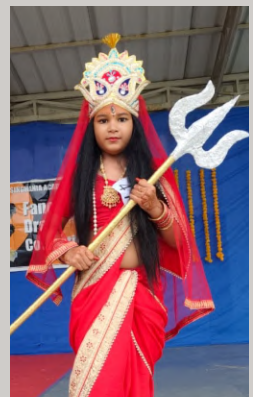

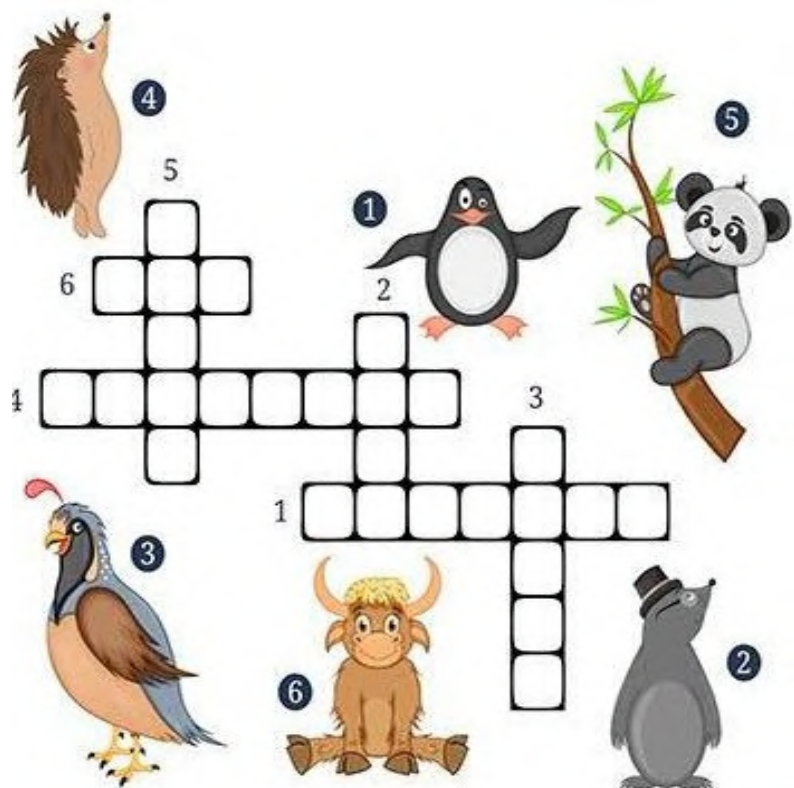
