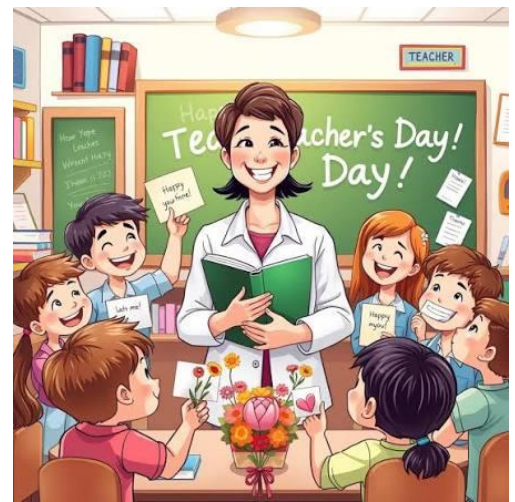
**Dear Parent,

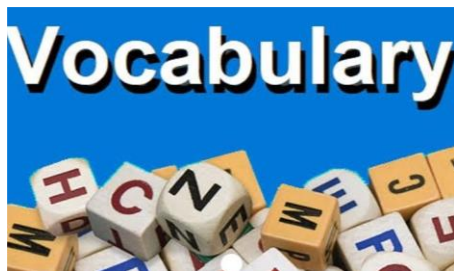

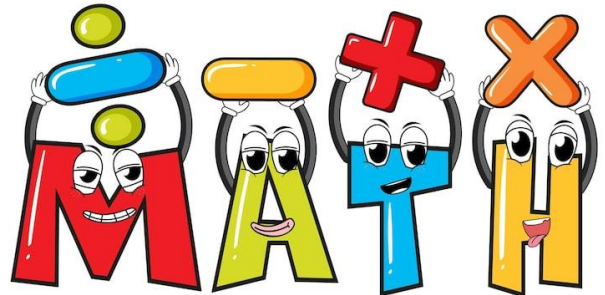
