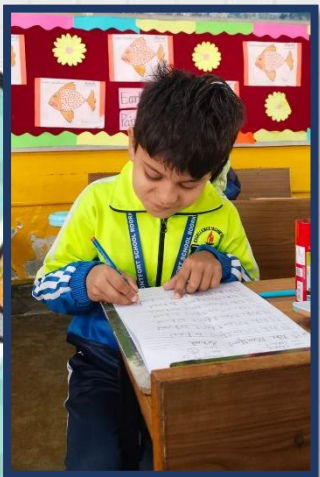


# HANDWRITING COMPETITION

# BEST SINGERS IN PRE-PRIMARY

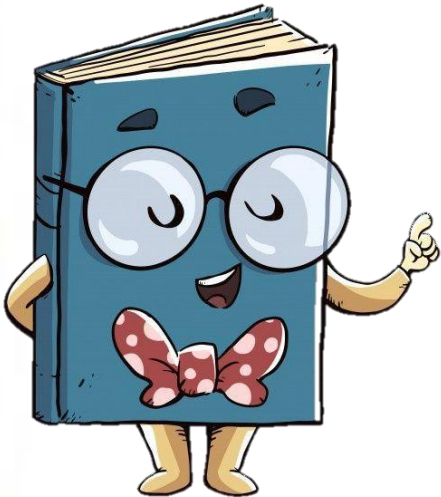

# BEST DANCERS IN PRE - PRIMARY

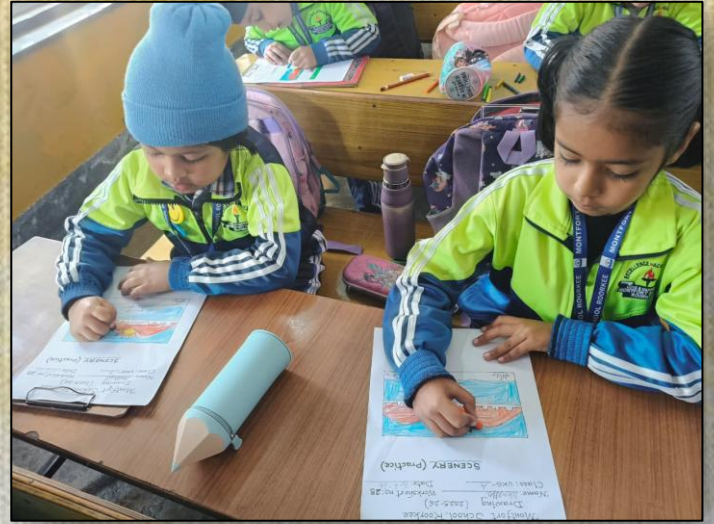

Their energy and enthusiasm added colour and vibrancy to every school occasion. We appreciate and encourage our little dancers to continue nurturing their dancing talents.



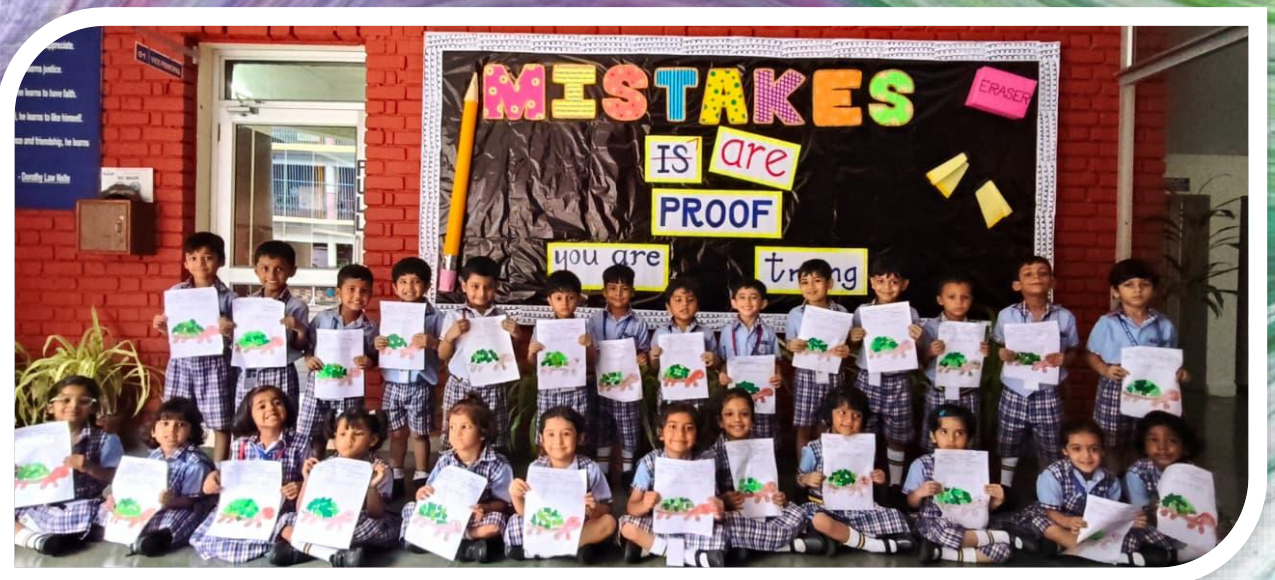
