Suggested Activities

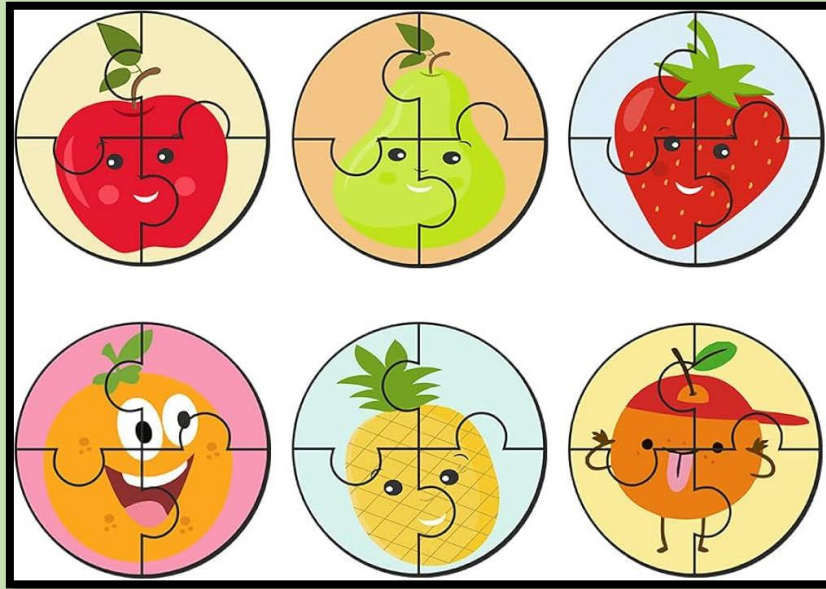


Make your child create different objects with play dough.

FAMILY PHOTO FRAME

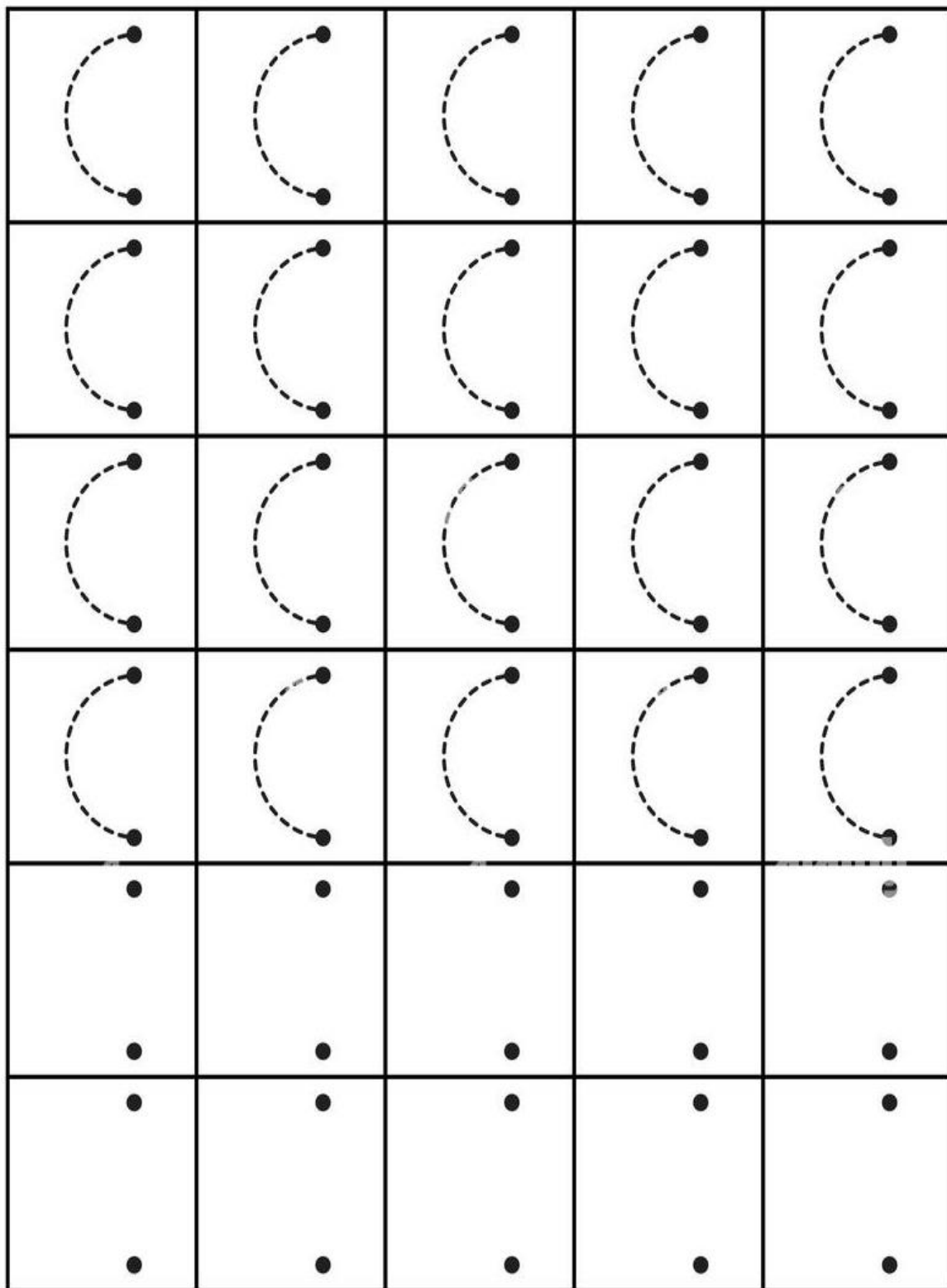


Let's make family photo frame:

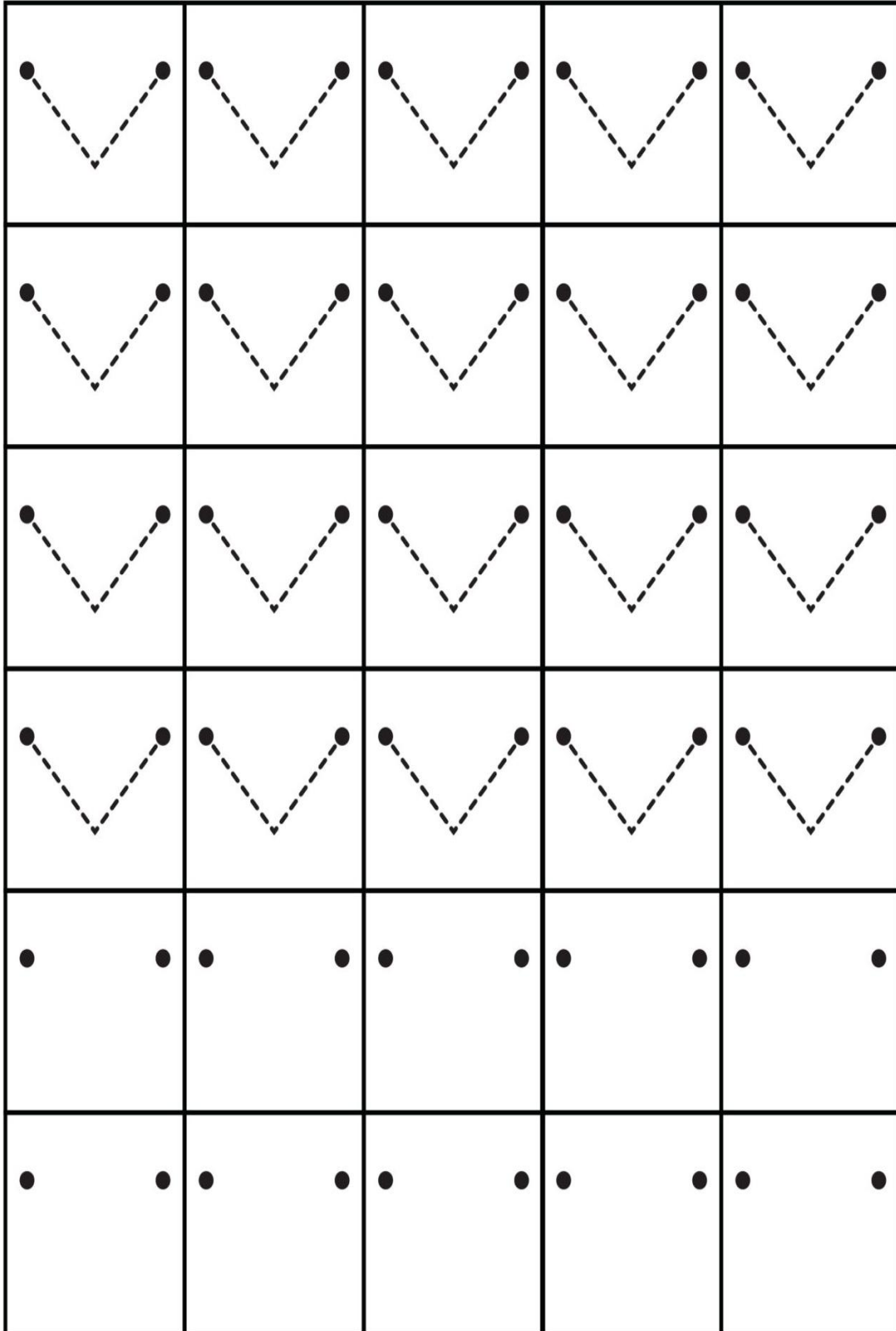
1. Take a rectangular cardboard base.

Your Family photo frame is ready.

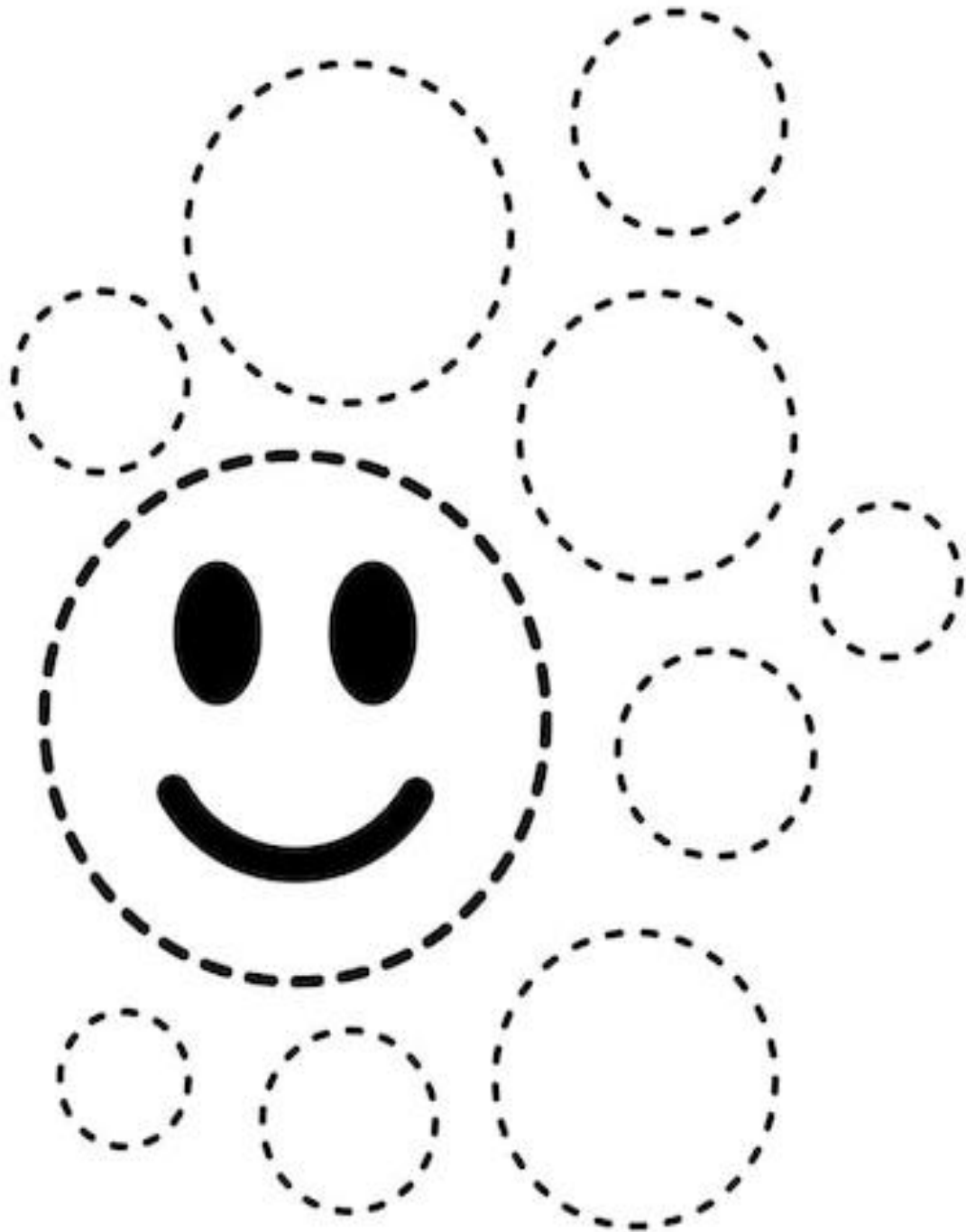

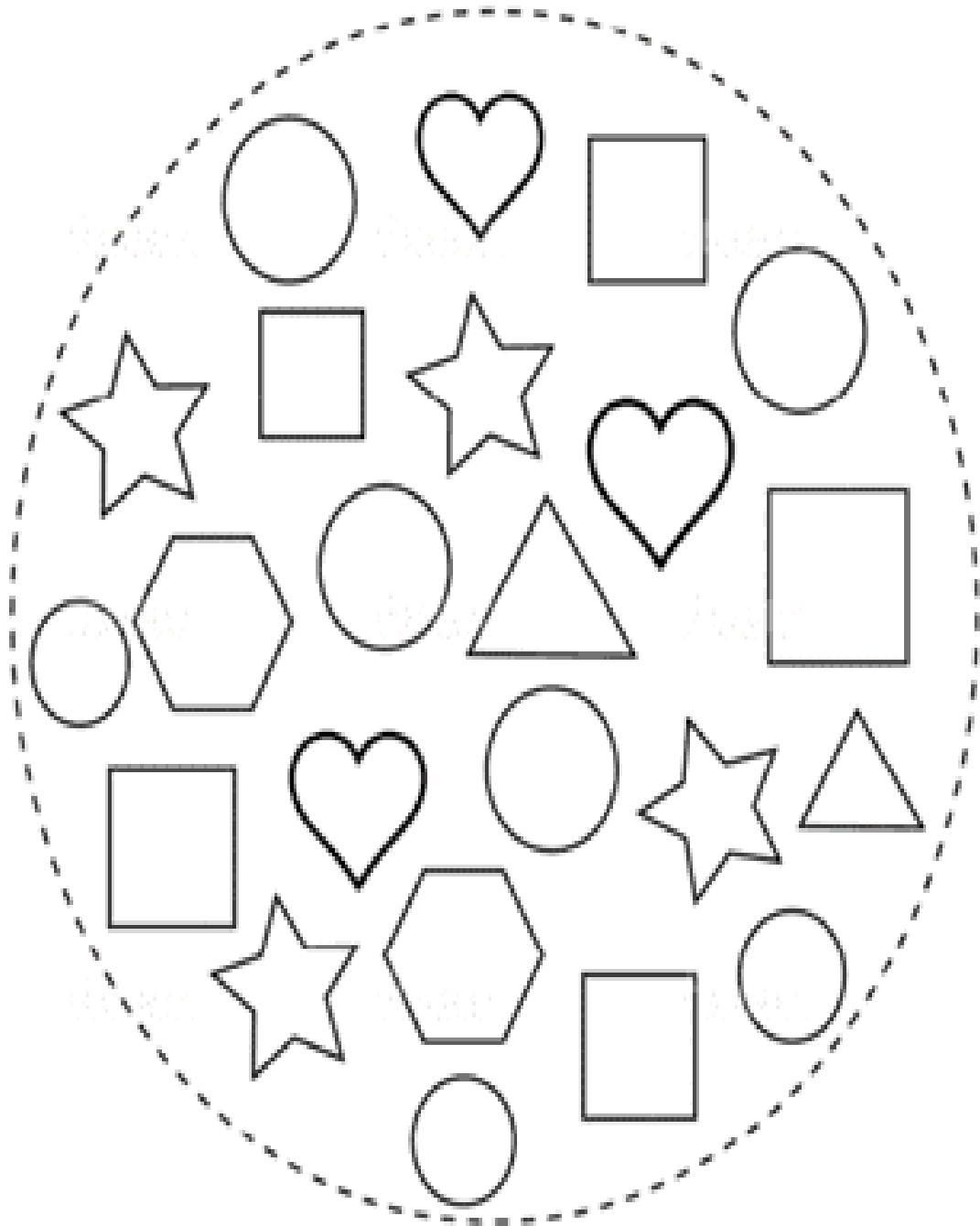

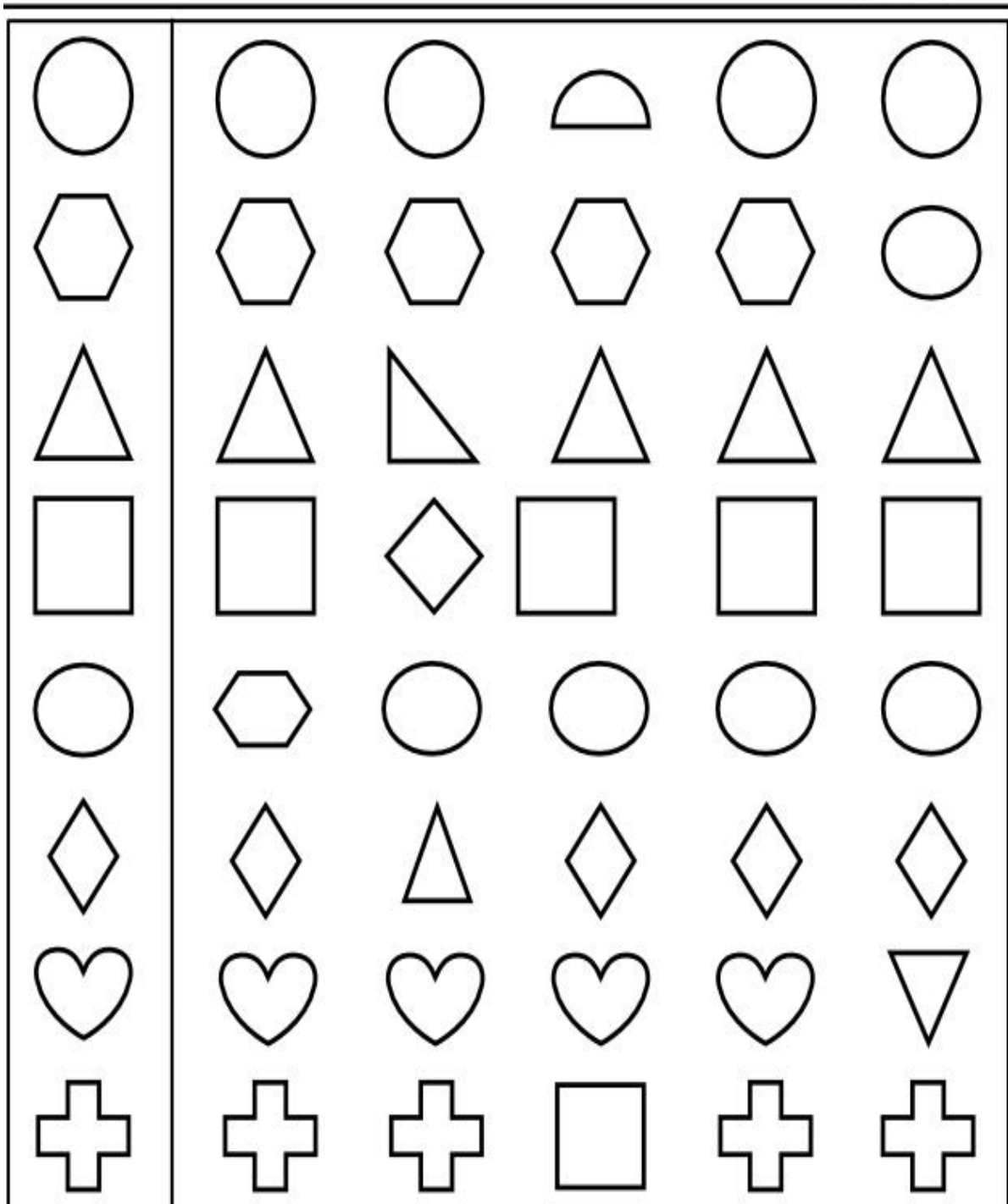
Trace the circles



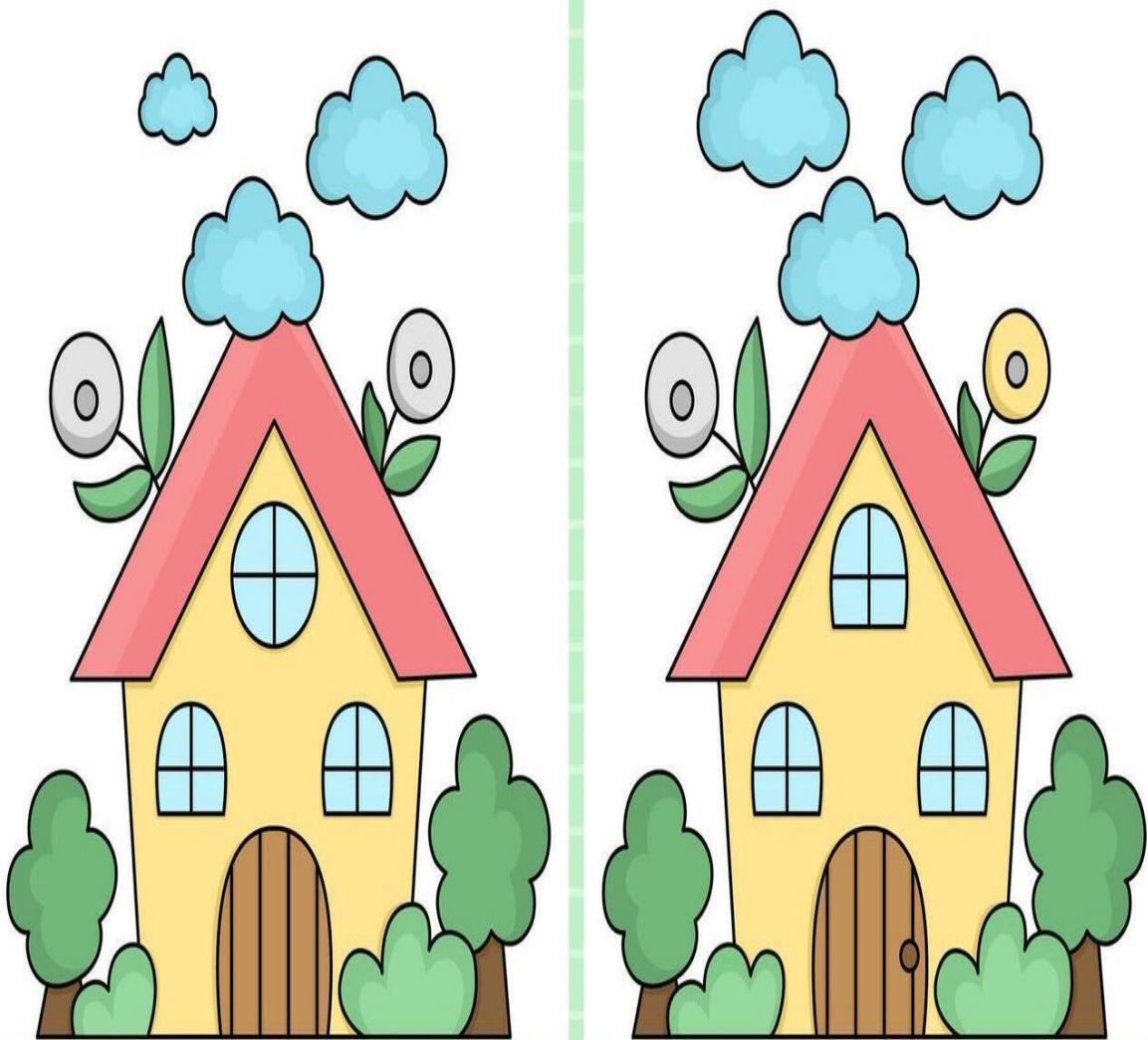
Colour all the circles

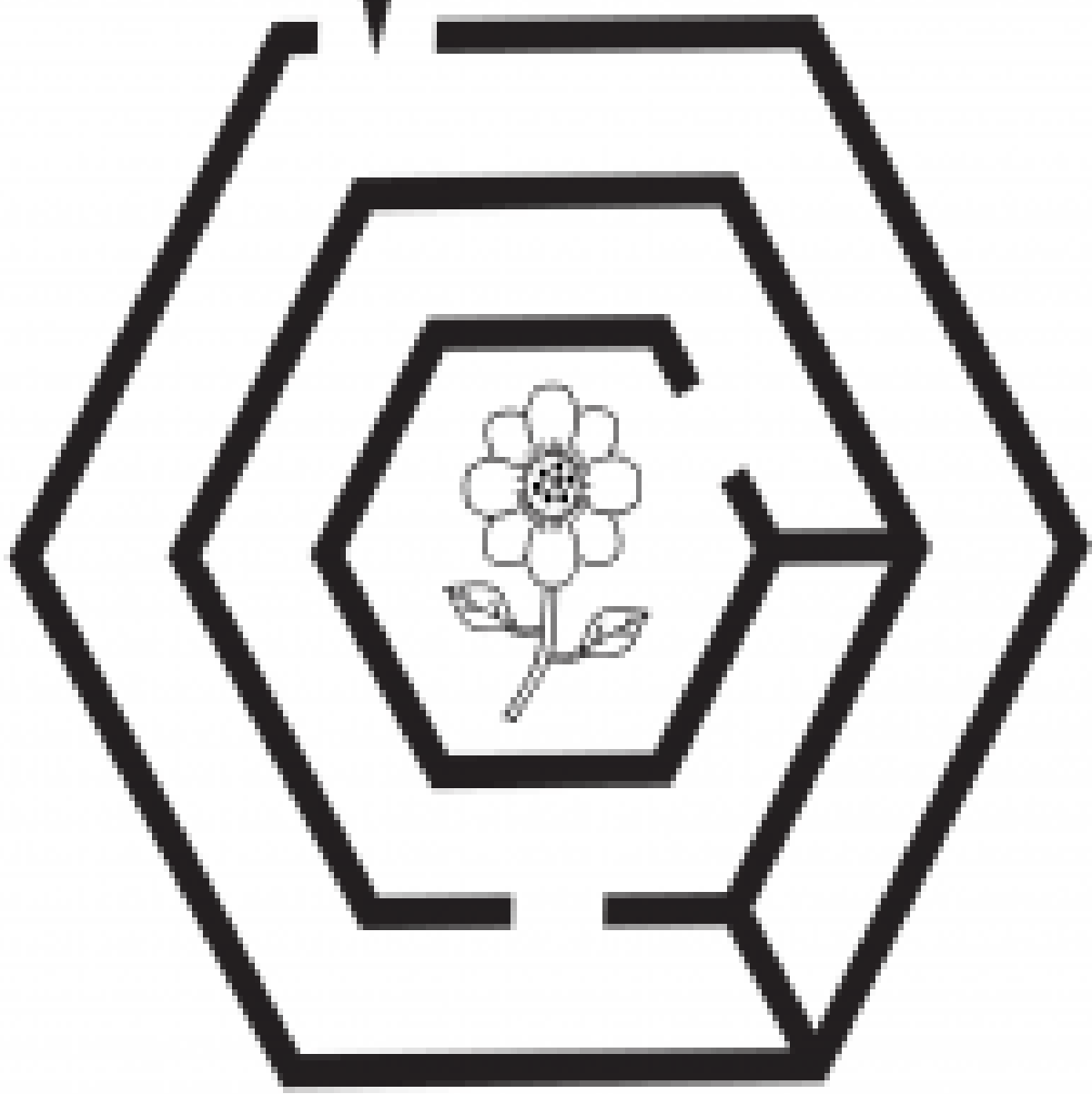

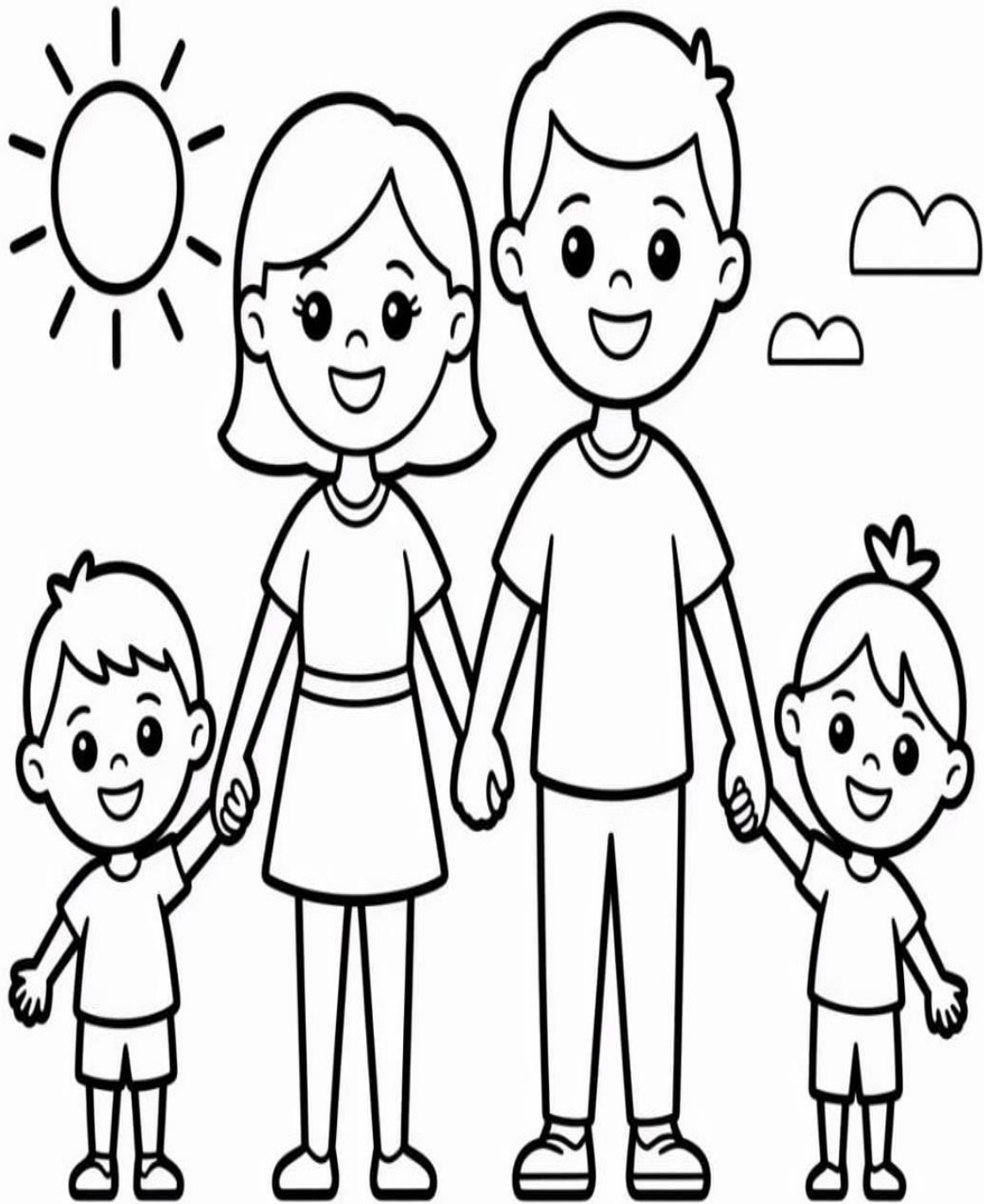
Help the ladybug find its way to the flower.



Help the bee reach the flower.



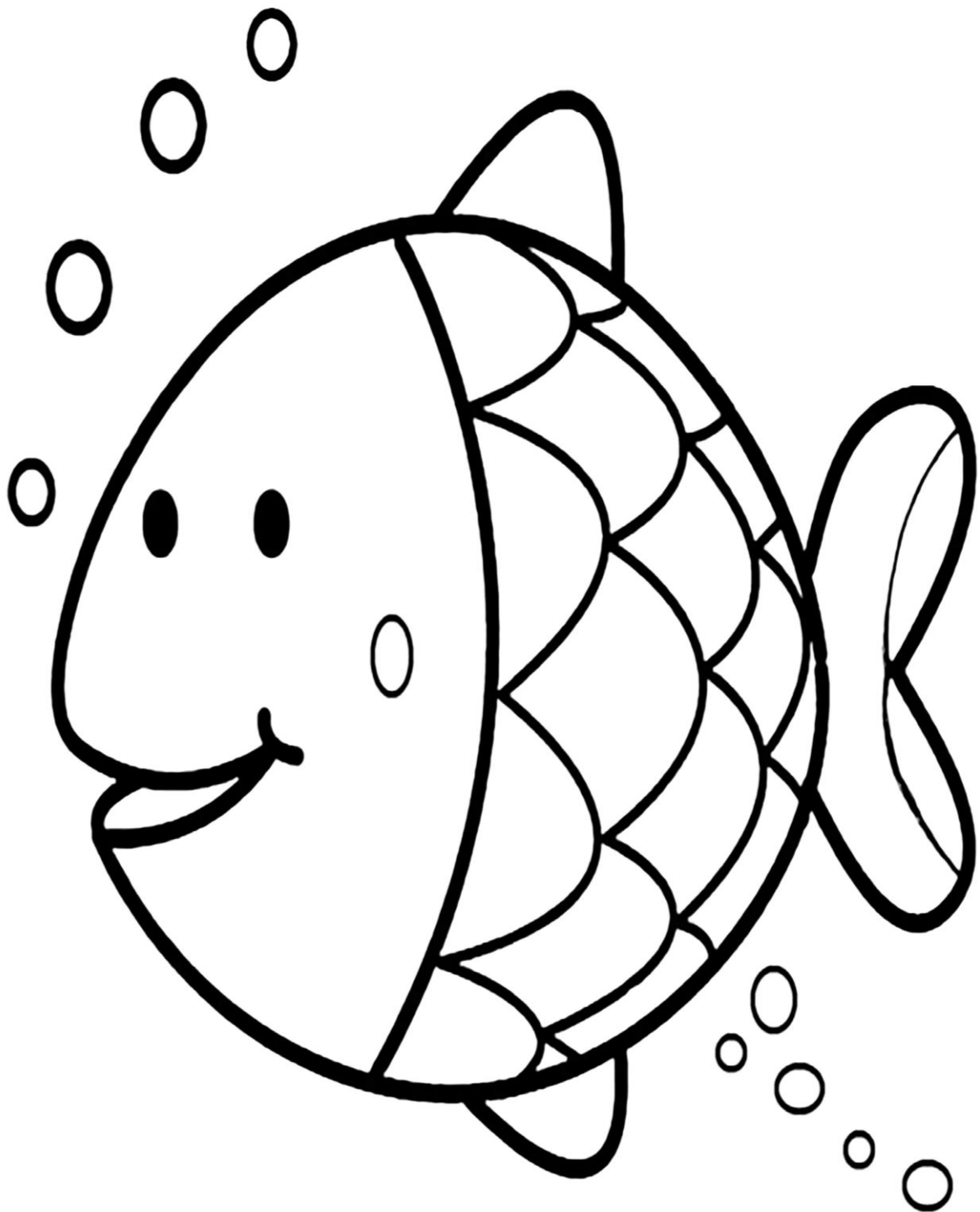
Colour the picture of the family.



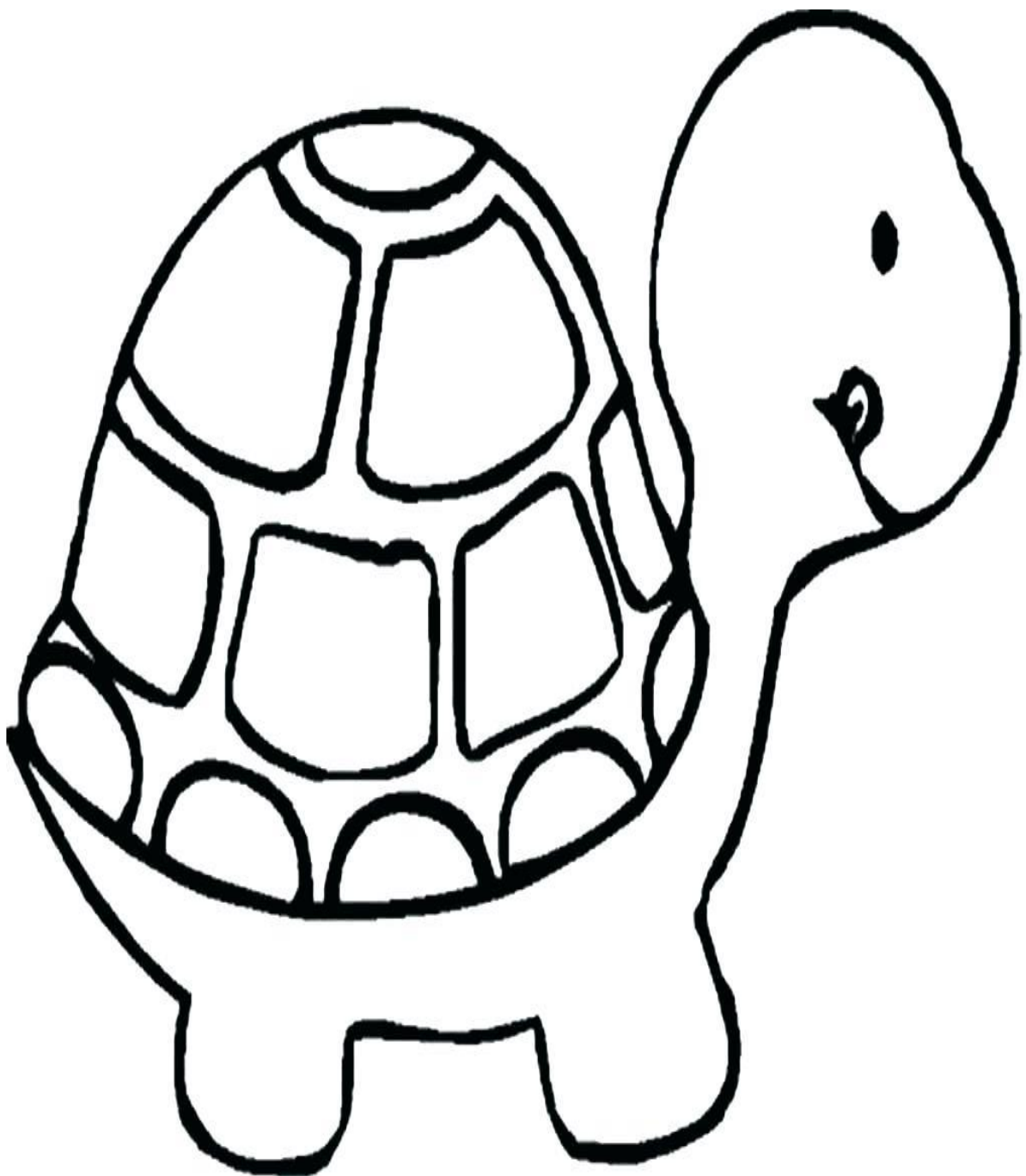
Use earbud impressions and paints of different colours to decorate the picture.
