Students who wish to pursue French as an additional language, alongside Sanskrit, will be facilitated through special classes scheduled on the first and third Saturdays.

Kindly note the following:

French will be offered only as an enrichment subject for one year (2026-27).

No formal examination or assessment in French will be conducted by the school.

All Class VI students will hence be placed in sections as allotted during the Class V annual result declaration.

Parents who wish to opt for French classes for their ward are requested to fill in the consent form and submit it to the class teacher by Thursday, 23rd April 2026.
