Dear Parents,

As you are aware that the CBSE has made amendments in the scheme of studies to align with the National Curriculum Framework for School Education (NCFSE-2023) and NEP-2020.

In this regard, the Directorate of Education (DoE), GNCT of Delhi has issued the revised **Examination Procedure and Promotion Policy for Class IX** via order No. DE.5/212/Exam/16-17/Part-I/619-629 effective from the Academic Session 2026-27.

The key provisions and promotion rules governing Class IX are mentioned below for your reference:

1. **Vocational Education** (Kaushal Vikas) is introduced as a mandatory core main subject for all Class IX students along with five other subjects: **English (R1), Hindi (R2), Mathematics, Science and Social Science.**
2. **Sanskrit/French (R3)** is a mandatory qualifying subject assessed entirely through school-based internal assessment. **No student shall be eligible to appear in the Class X Board Examination unless they have qualified Class IX Third Language (R3).** The marksheet will distinctly reflect "Qualified/Not Qualified". A minimum of 33% marks will be required to qualify.
3. Compulsory areas including **Individuals in Society, Art Education, Physical Education & Well-Being, and Computational Thinking & Artificial Intelligence (CT & AI)** will be evaluated through school-based assessments.
4. **Additional Subject:** Information Technology will be offered as an additional subject.
5. To be declared "**Pass**" at the end of the session, a student must fulfil the following mandatory and cumulative conditions:
 - A student must secure at least **33% marks separately in Internal Assessment/Practical and 33% marks in External Assessment** (Mid-Term Exam plus Annual Exam) in each of the six main subjects.
 - A student must secure a **minimum of 25% marks in the Annual Examination** in each of the six main subjects.
 - A student failing in **not more than three main subjects** out of six is eligible to appear in the **Compartment Examination.**
 - A student who is not eligible for Pass, Promotion, or Compartment Examination shall be declared "**Essential Repeat**" and detained in Class IX during the next session.

We request all parents to make note of these changes in the new academic structure and ensure that your ward prepares accordingly.
