## Sorting by Shapes



### Material Required

- A4 size pastel sheet.
- Small cut outs of circle ,square and triangle

### Instructions:

- Take A4 size cut outs of circle, square and triangle with faces drawn on them. Cut out a hole for mouth in each shape.
- Fix them on the table/hard surface so that the shapes are standing as shown in the picture.
- Give assorted cut-outs to your child and encourage him/her to sort them according to shape and put them in the mouth of the respective shape.

# Fun with Patterns



## Material Required

- Different patterns drawn on A4 size sheet.
- Pulses

## Instructions:

- Draw different patterns like standing lines, sleeping lines, Zig-Zag, spiral and curves on an A4 size sheet
- Encourage your child to place the pulses on the drawn patterns.

## Ball - Fall



### Material required:

- Balls/small toys
- 2 big bowls

### Instructions:

- Give you ward assorted balls/toys in a large bowl.
- Encourage your child to pick the balls/toys with the help of a strainer and transfer them in an empty bowl.

## Pasta in the stick



### Material Required

- Penne Pasta
- Kulfi -sticks
- Wheat dough

### Instructions:

- Make a round wheat dough and fix the stick in the dough as shown in the picture.
- Give your child some penne pasta in the bowl and encourage him/her to put the pasta one by one in the sticks.

## Blow with Straw



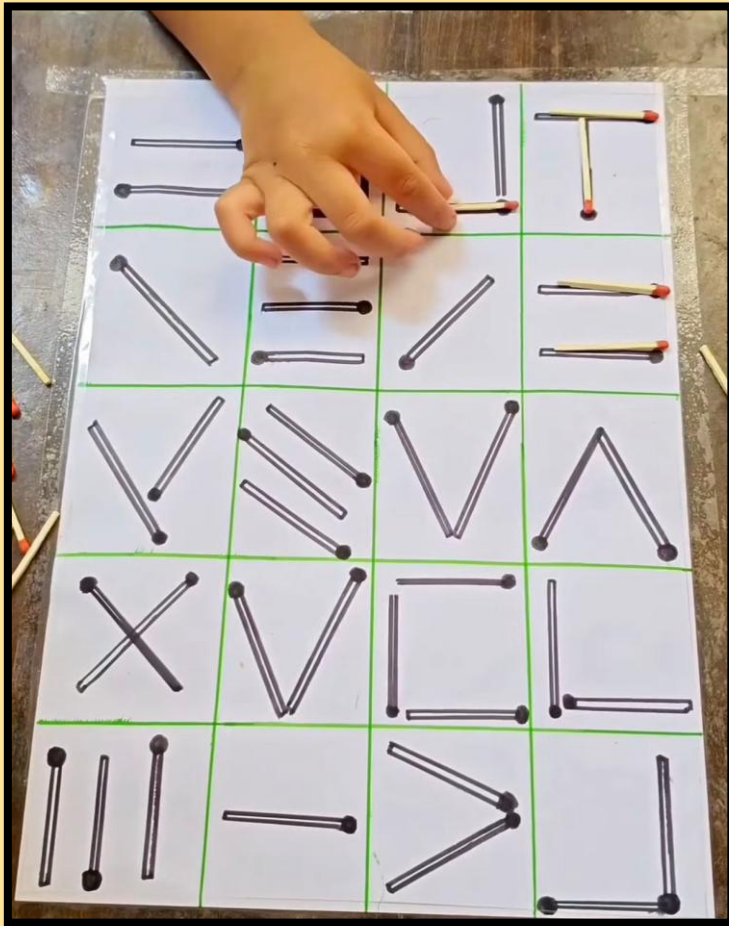
### Material Required-

- 10 -12 Paper cups with flat bottom
- Straw
- Pom Poms

### Instructions –

- Put 4-5 paper cups upside down with a pom-pom on each of the glass.
- Place a glass with hollow side up next to each glass with pom poms as shown in the picture.
- Encourage your child to blow through the straw to move the pom poms to the empty cups.

## Patterns with match sticks



### Material Required

- Matchsticks/earbuds
- Paper
- pen

### Instructions –

- Draw a few line patterns on an A4 size white sheet as shown in the picture.
- Encourage your child to place the matchsticks/earbuds on the drawn patterns.

## Dough Much Fun



**Play dough is a lot of fun  
for the child**

**Take refined flour or wheat  
flour. Add a little oil and food  
colour to it. Knead it to make  
a play dough at home.  
Encourage your child to roll,  
pat, squeeze, stretch, pat,  
poke and pinch the play  
dough.**

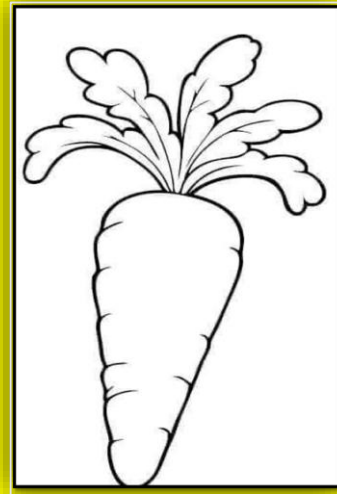
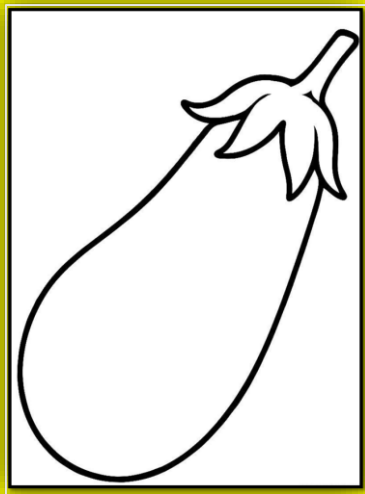
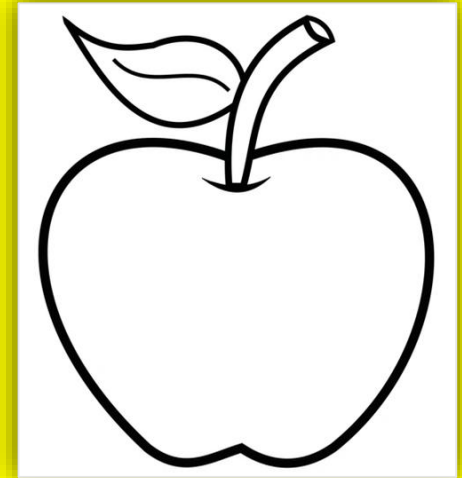
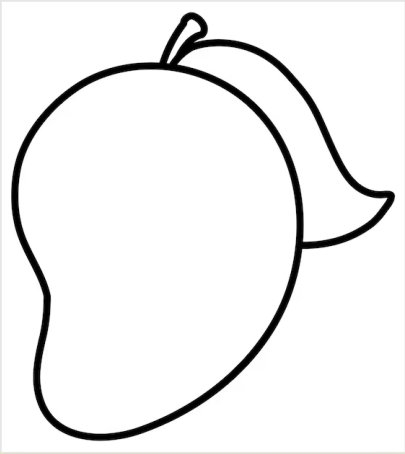
**Take your child to a supermarket. Buy fruits and vegetables with him/her. Make simple conversations with your child like discussing the names/colour of different fruits and vegetables.**

**Encourage your child to learn the name of their favorite fruit/vegetable and of their family members.**










# Eye/Face Mask



## Material required –

- Fruit cutout on an A4 size sheet.
- Elastic thread

## Instructions –

- Take an A4 size cutout of any fruit.
- Do sponge printing or bubble wrap printing on the cutout. Let it dry.
- Now cut out two holes to make eyes of the mask.
- Tie a string at the two ends of the mask.

# Head Gears



## Materials Required:

- Coloured pastel sheets
- Glitter sheet (for eyes and leaf)
- Fevistick

## Instructions:

- Cut a strip of pastel sheet to make the headband. sheet (18 inches long X 3 inches wide)
- Take cutout of your favourite fruit (5 inches)
- Help your child do finger printing, thumb printing, cotton dabbing or sponge printing, on the head band using poster colours.
- Cut green leaf with glitter sheet and paste on the top of the fruit.
- Make the eyes of the fruit as shown in the picture.

# Pasta and Fryums activity



## Material required

- Pasta
- Fryums
- Paint and brush
- A4 size fruit cutouts (any two fruits)
- Thick card board

## Instruction

- Take cutouts of any two fruits of your child's choice from coloured pastel sheets. (size 10 inches)
- Paste these cutouts on mount board.
- Mix yellow and green poster colour and water of medium consistency in bowl. Dip your fryums and pasta in it for sometime.
- Take them out from their bowls and let them dry for a day. Now, paste these on the fruit cutout as shown in the sample.
- Use a pair of big wiggly eyes and marker to make a face.

# Strawberry with paper plate



## Material required

- Eco friendly plate (full size)
- Poster colours – red
- Paint brush
- Green A4 size sheet

## Instructions-

- Make your child paint the paper plate with red poster colour using paint and brush.
- Encourage your child to make seeds of the strawberry by doing ear-bud printing/pasting black bindis.
- Cut the leaf from green sheet and paste it on the plate as shown in the picture

# Grapes with crumpling paper



## Material Required

- Purple crape paper
- A4 size white sheet
- Green glitter sheet

## Instructions

- Encourage your child to crumple and make paper balls with purple or green crape paper.
- Take an A4 size sheet and paste the crumpled paper balls as shown in the sample.
- Make the leaves of the grapes using glitter sheet.
