

Nature Walk.....



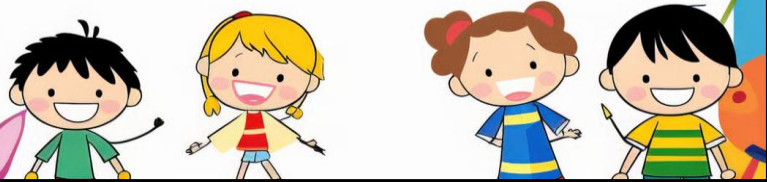
- Take your child out for a walk in the morning and let him/her explore the surroundings. Have friendly conversations with your child encouraging him/her to talk about what they see in complete sentences.

Fine Motor Skill

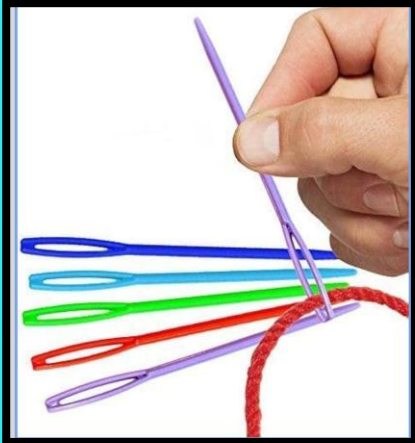
- Building blocks

Needle - Art



Material Required

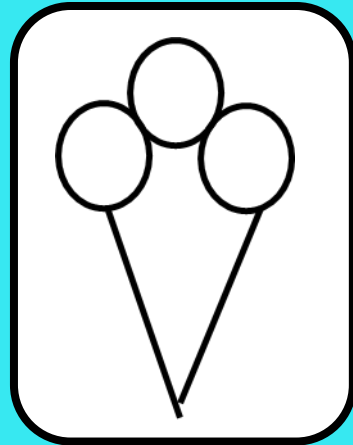
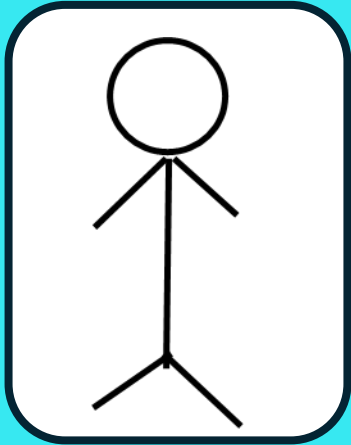
- Child friendly plastic needle
- Thread
- Cardboard
- Punching machine



Procedure

- Cut out different shapes from the cardboard.
- Punch holes along the edge of the shapes.
- Thread the needle and encourage your ward to needle the holes as shown in the picture.

Material Required

Material Required

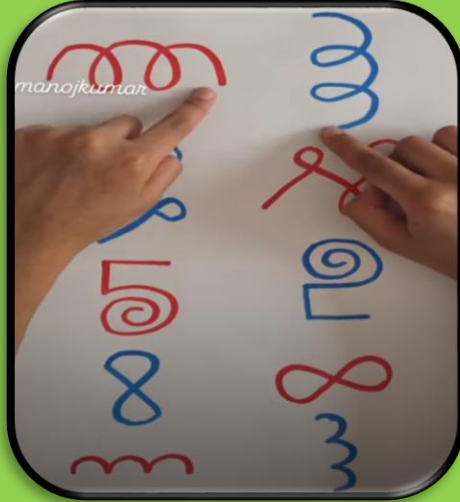
- 3 plastic glasses

BRAIN BOOSTER

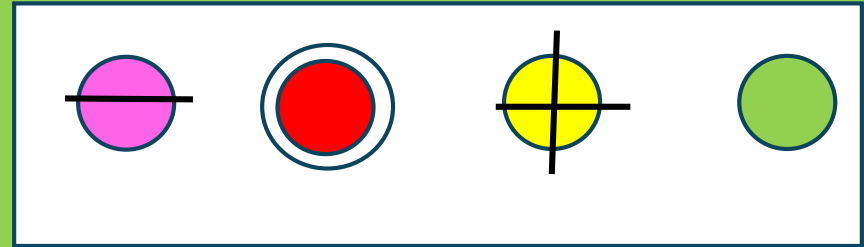


Material Required

- A thick white sheet of paper

Procedure

- Draw 5 patterns on left side of the sheet and 5 different patterns on the right side of the sheet

Material required

- Cardboard box of medium size
- Ice cream sticks
- Fevicol

Procedure

1. Take a cardboard box of medium size.
2. Use the flaps to make the roof of the house.
3. Cut the door and windows out of it.
4. Paste ice cream sticks on the house.
5. Paint only the roof of the house using bright acrylic colour.



Himachali Dolls



Material Required

- An old plastic bottle
- Clay/ cloth ball/tennis ball
- Different pieces of cloth to make the traditional dress of Himachal Pradesh for the dolls.
- Black Thread
- Tiny beads for traditional jewelery
- Acrylic paints for facial features.



Procedure

1. Use a small plastic bottle as a sturdy base for the doll's torso.
2. Use a ball of clay/a ball of fabric/tennis ball to make the head. Make the features such as eyes, nose, lips with the paint.
3. Attach the head to the body.
4. Dress the doll in traditional Himachali costume.
5. Use black yarn or thread to create braids or a bun.
6. Use jewelery to decorate your doll.



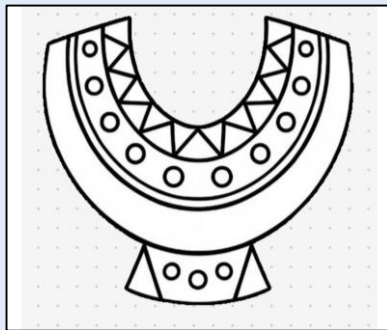
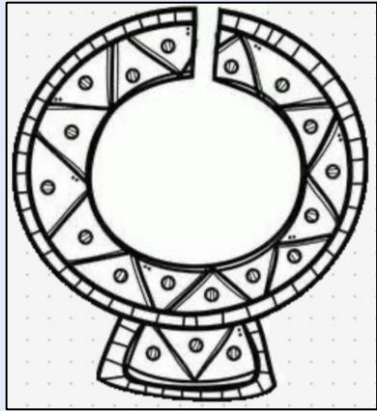
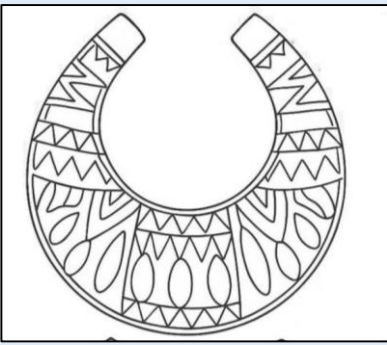
Timeless Jewel

Material Required

- Printout of any one necklace with geometrical shapes
- Sketch pens
- Ivory sheet
- Decoration material such as mirrors, glitter tubes, and stone stickers
- String to tie the necklace

Procedure

- Take a printout of a necklace
- Colour it with sketch pens
- Decorate it with mirrors, stone stickers, and glitter
- Paste it on an ivory sheet to give it a base.
- Cut the necklace and attach string to it to make the necklace



Bottle Art



Material Required

- Sturdy Plastic Bottle
- Coloured Jute rope
- Fevicol
- Decorative Material- Artificial flowers, shells, mirrors, stone stickers

Procedure

1. Take a sturdy plastic bottle.
2. Apply Fevicol around the bottle.
3. Wrap coloured jute rope around the bottle covering it from base to the top. You may use ropes of two or more colours to make it colourful.
4. Decorate the wrapped bottle with a variety of decoration material. .

WIND CHIME



Material Required

- Mount board or a hanger
- Poster colours
- Beads
- Thick wool or a thread

Procedure

1. Cut a ring of diameter 12 inches from the mount board. You may also use a hanger.
2. Cut different geometrical shapes from mount board. (Size: 4 to 5 inches)
3. Paint these cut-outs with poster colours.
4. Decorate them on both sides as shown in the picture.
5. String the bead and the cutouts and tie them around the ring/hanger.

SPOONS OF FLAVOUR



Material Required

- 2 large size wooden spoons
- Acrylic Paints
- Glitter Tube



Procedure

1. Take 2 wooden spoons and paint them with bright acrylic colour.
2. Make geometrical patterns on them as shown in the picture.
3. Use a glitter tube to highlight the patterns.
