



## Nature Walk.....



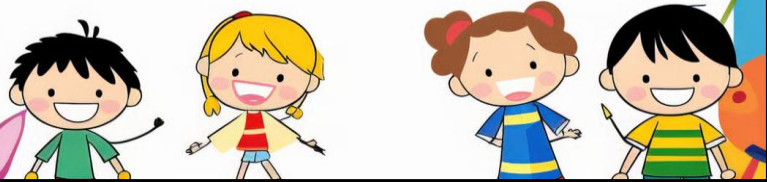
- Take your child out for a walk in the morning and let him/her explore the surroundings. Have friendly conversations with your child encouraging him/her to talk about what they see in complete sentences.

### Fine Motor Skill

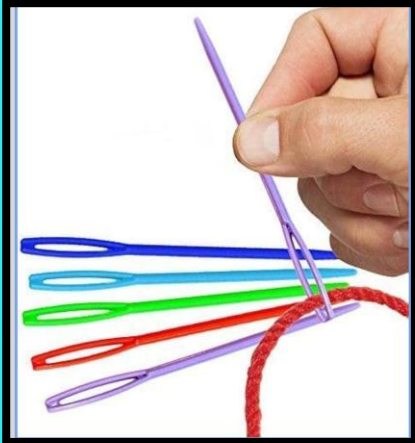
- Building blocks

# Needle - Art



## Material Required

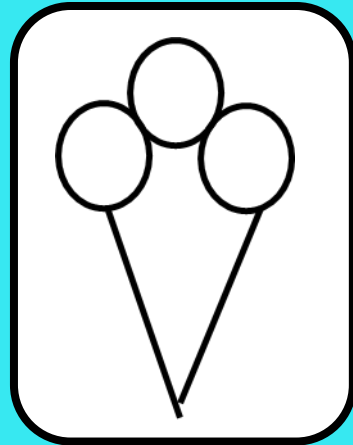
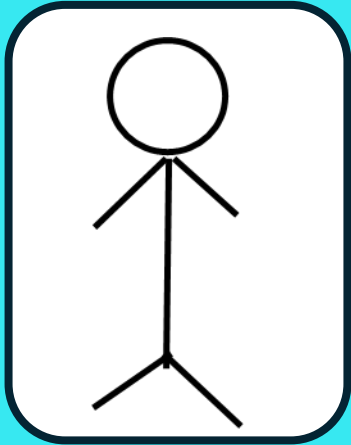
- Child friendly plastic needle

## Procedure

- Cut out different shapes from the cardboard.

- Thread the needle and encourage your ward to needle the holes as shown in the picture.

# MATCHING



## Material Required

## Material Required

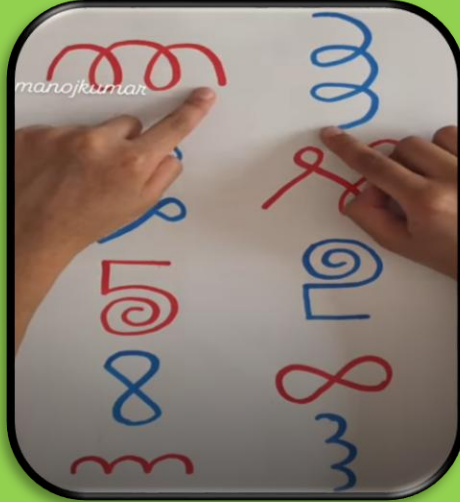
- 3 plastic glasses

# BRAIN BOOSTER

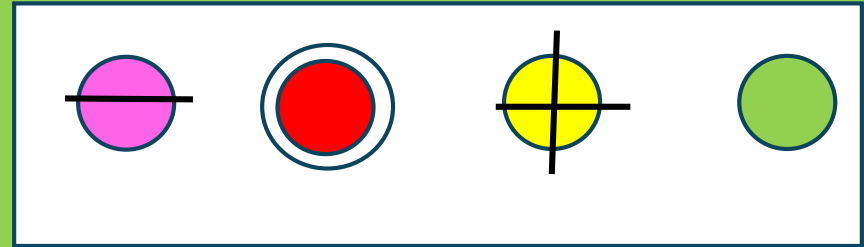


## Material Required

# JHAROKHA



## Procedure

1. Take a cardboard box.
2. Cut an arch shape on the front side of the box to make jharokha.
3. Paint/ cover the box from inside and outside with bright colored paper.
4. Decorate the jharokha with artificial flowers , lace, mirrors ,stones and beads.

## Material Required

- A large size box.
- Bright colored sheets/ Acrylic Paints
- Decoration material like artificial flowers, stone stickers, beads, mirrors, tassels , bells etc.
- Bandhani/ Gujarati fabric (Optional)

# WALL HANGING



## Material Required

- Mount board (size – 10 to 12 inches)
- Paints/ bright colored Paper
- Decoration material such as beads, strings, mirrors, bells, tassels
- Thread/ribbon

## Procedure

1. Cut a shape from the mount board as shown in the picture.
2. Paint the base or paste fabric/ bright colored paper on it.
3. Decorate it with the help of beads, strings etc.
4. Punch holes on top and tie a thread or ribbon.

# GARBA DANCER



## Material Required

- Mount Board
- Bright Fabric/ pastel sheets
- Decorative material -Glitter Sheet , Lace, mirrors, shells, stone stickers, beads etc.
- Wooden sticks

## Procedure

1. Use the mount board to make the body of a garba dancer as shown in the picture ( Height - 12 inches ).
2. Use bright coloured pastel sheet/fabric to make a round flared skirt and dupatta.
3. Decorate the dress with mirrors, bright lace, stone stickers and beads.
4. Make sticks with the rolled paper and decorate them.
5. Make the garba dancers hold the decorated garba sticks.

# GUJARATI FANS



## Material Required

- Mount board
- Fabric/Pastel sheets
- Decorative Material-Ghungroo /Bells/ Stone stickers/Tassels/ Satin frills
- Wooden stick/ dandiya stick

## Procedure

1. Take a mount board and cut it in the shape of a fan as shown in the picture.
2. Paste and cover it with bright coloured fabric/paper.
3. Use lace/frill to give it a border.
4. Decorate the fan with mirrors, bells, ghungroo, shells etc.
5. Fix it on the Dandiya stick/ wooden handle

# DECORATIVE PLATES



## Material Required

- 2 Eco friendly/ Terracotta plates of full size
- Acrylic paints
- Mirrors, Bright Acrylic Paints
- Brush



## Procedure

1. Draw any geometrical design or patterns on the plates.
2. Use bright colours to paint the design.
3. Decorate the plates with the mirrors.
