 - School-based annual exam in Class IX (from 2026–27)
 - Board Examination in Class X (from 2027–28)
 - Duration: 3 hours

Optional Advanced Subjects

3. Mathematics Advanced

- Nature: Optional
- Syllabus: Additional advanced content
- Assessment:
 - 25 marks
 - Board Examination in Class X (from 2027–28 onwards)
 - Duration: 1 hour
 - Question Type: All HOTS (Higher Order Thinking Skills)

4. Science Advanced

- Nature: Optional
- Syllabus: Additional advanced content
- Assessment:
 - 25 marks
 - Board Examination in Class X (from 2027–28 onwards)
 - Duration: 1 hour
 - Question Type: All HOTS (Higher Order Thinking Skills)

- Mathematics and Science are **mandatory subjects** for all students.
- Advanced papers in both subjects are **optional**.
- Standard exams are **80 marks (3 hours)**, while advanced exams are **25 marks (1 hour)**.
- Advanced papers focus only on **HOTS-based questions**.
- Implementation starts from **2026–27 (Class IX)** and **2027–28 (Class X Board Exams)**.

FOR MARKSHEET

A candidate securing 50 % and above marks for the optional Advanced Examination shall have the following recorded in the marksheet: THE ADVANCED LEVEL HAS BEEN SUCCESSFULLY CLEARED. (This text is tentative and may vary).

However, the marks obtained in the Advanced Examination shall not be added to the overall aggregate or total score. In case a candidate secures less than the prescribed criteria, no reference to the Advanced Level shall be reflected in the marksheet.

12. Three-Language Formula (From Class VI)

- The **Three-Language Formula** will be **mandatory** from the session **2026–27** for students currently in **Class VI**:
 - **R1:** English
 - **R2:** Hindi
 - **R3:** Sanskrit / Punjabi
- **For Class X:**
 - R3 will remain **optional up to the session 2029–30**
 - R3 will become **mandatory from session 2030–31**
 - Assessment will be **school-based (no Board Examination)**
