The exhibition will be open for parents from **9:30 am to 1:00 pm**. Please find the e-invite enclosed.

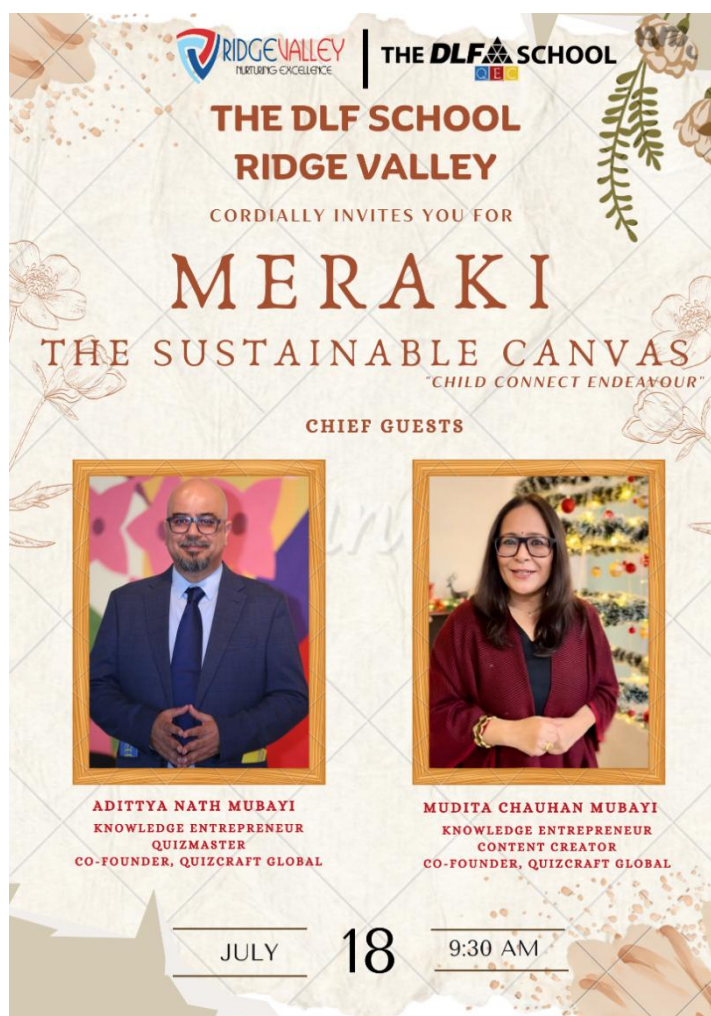
