DAY 01: SCHOOL – MUSSOORIE

- Departure from school for **Mussoorie** by AC Deluxe Bus at 05:00 a.m. (260 kms – 6 hrs. approx.)
- Breakfast enroute at the restaurant
- Arrival in Mussoorie
- Lunch followed by hotel check-in (early check-in is subject to availability)
- Time for rest and freshen up

- Evening exploration to **Mall Road**
- Late evening return to the hotel
- Dinner and overnight stay in Mussoorie

DAY 02: MUSSOORIE

- Early breakfast at the hotel
- Depart for a trek to **George Everest** (Difficulty Level: Easy) Trek Distance: 4 km | Trek Duration: 5 hours The George Everest trek near Mussoorie, India, is an easy, family-friendly day hike to the historic home and observatory of Sir George Everest, offering stunning views of the Himalayan range and Doon Valley, accessible via scenic trails through oak, pine, and deodar forests from Hathipaon Chowk.
- Reach the summit climbing through the forest and switchback
- Packed lunch will be provided at George Everest summit view point
- Evening return to the hotel
- **Music and Dance** at the hotel
- Dinner and overnight stay in Mussoorie

- Finalize & submit **Students' Media Projects**

- Depart from Dehradun for **School** by AC Deluxe Bus (230 kms – 5+ hrs. approx.)

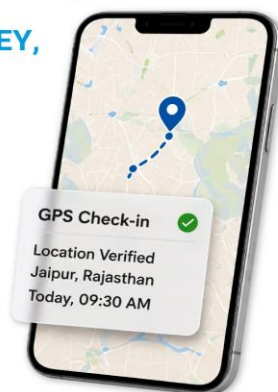

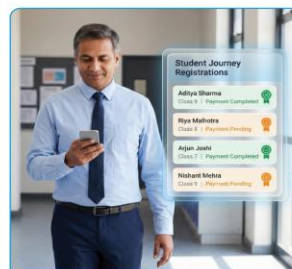
