Magnets and Magnetism

The Invisible force



What is a Magnet?

A magnet is an object that produces an invisible force called magnetism. This force can attract certain materials like iron, nickel, or cobalt. Magnets come in many shapes and sizes - from tiny ones in earbuds to huge magnets used in junkyards to lift cars!

What Are Magnetic Poles?

Magnets have two ends, called poles:

- The North Pole
- The South Pole

When you bring two magnets close:

- Opposite poles attract (North + South)
- Same poles repel (North + North or South + South)

Did You Know Earth is a Giant Magnet?

Yes! Earth has a magnetic field caused by the movement of molten iron inside its core. That's why compasses always point north — they follow Earth's magnetic field.

Types of Magnets

- Permanent Magnets – Always magnetic (e.g., fridge magnets).
- Temporary Magnets – Become magnetic only when near a magnet.
- Electromagnets – Made by running electricity through wire wrapped around iron.
- These can be turned on and off!

Real-Life Uses of Magnets

- In electronics: Speakers, TVs, mobile phones
- In medicine: MRI machines use strong magnets
- In science: Particle accelerators use magnets to move tiny particles
- In homes: Refrigerator doors, cupboard latches

Try This Fun Experiment at Home!

You'll need:

- A magnet
- Some paper clips
- A plastic ruler or sheet of paper

Steps:

- Place the paper clips on to the table.
- Hold the magnet under the plastic or paper.
- Move it around and watch the clips move — like magic!

This shows how magnets can work even through other materials.

Fun Fact:

A magnet can lose its power if it's dropped too often or heated up too much!
