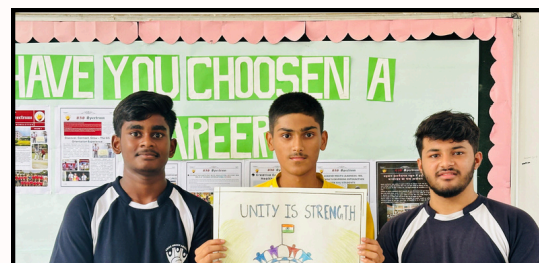

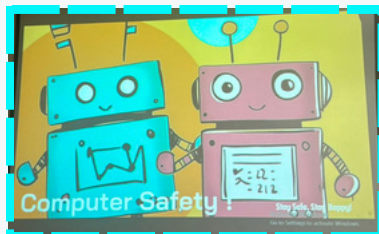

The young learners showed great enthusiasm and asked thoughtful questions, showing genuine curiosity about online safety.

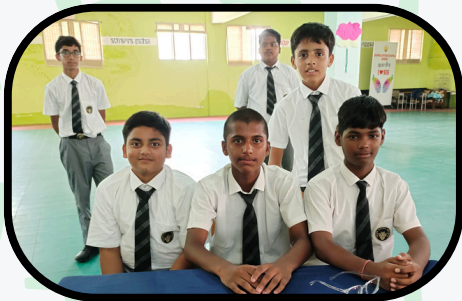
Meanwhile, the senior facilitators displayed strong leadership, empathy, and communication skills, making the session highly effective and relatable.

- Participation of both students and teachers, fostering collective responsibility





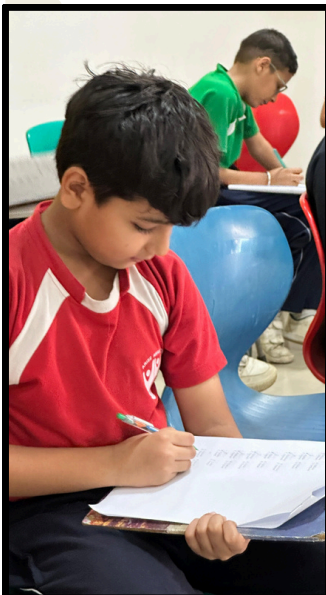
Intra-Class Spell Bee Competition (Grades 4–8)

Educational Visit to CSIR Lab, Okhla – 22nd July 2025

 **"Exploring the Genes that Define Us"**



A group of 9 student leaders from Class X (A & B) visited the CSIR Lab, Okhla, on 22nd July 2025, accompanied by Mr. Natesh Kumar, HOD Science. The visit provided hands-on exposure to DNA sequencing, genome mapping, and advanced lab tools like PCR machines, centrifuges, and microscopes. Students participated in a live DNA extraction activity using their own saliva samples and attended an engaging session by Chief Scientist Mr. Rakesh Sharma.

They explored key concepts such as genomic vectors, plasmids, bacterial applications, and witnessed real-time demonstrations. The interactive Q&A boosted their scientific curiosity and critical thinking. This enriching experience bridged textbook learning with real-world application. The Science Department recommends more such visits to promote experiential learning and research interest among students.

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India Spelling Bee – Regional Finale



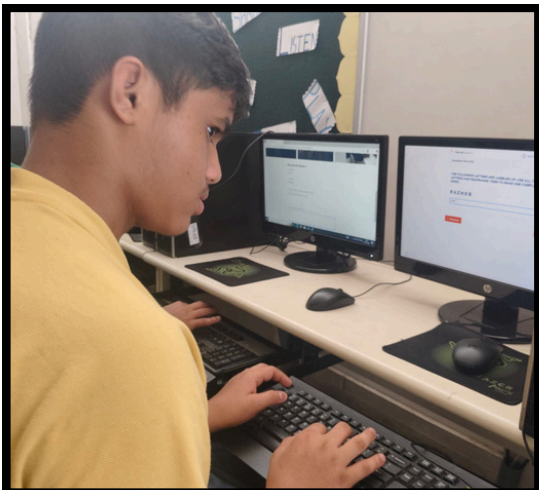
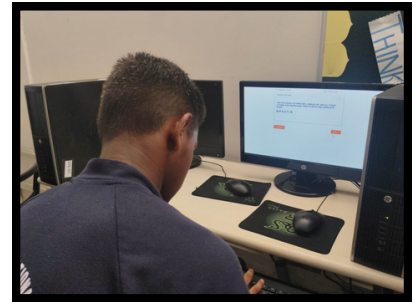
"Spell. Shine. Succeed!"

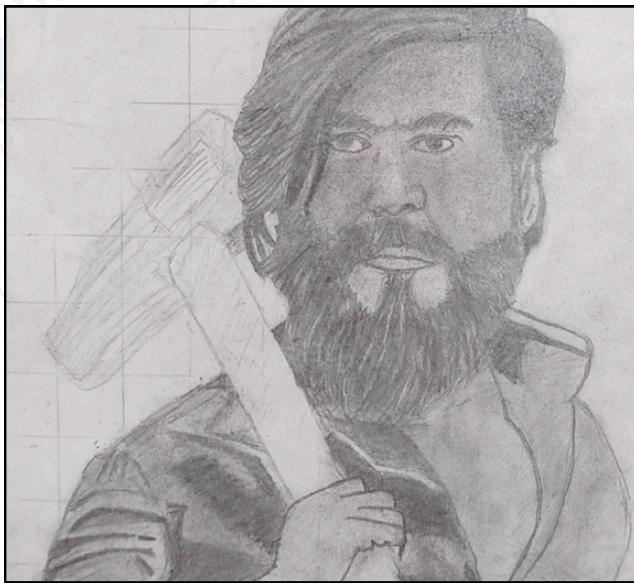

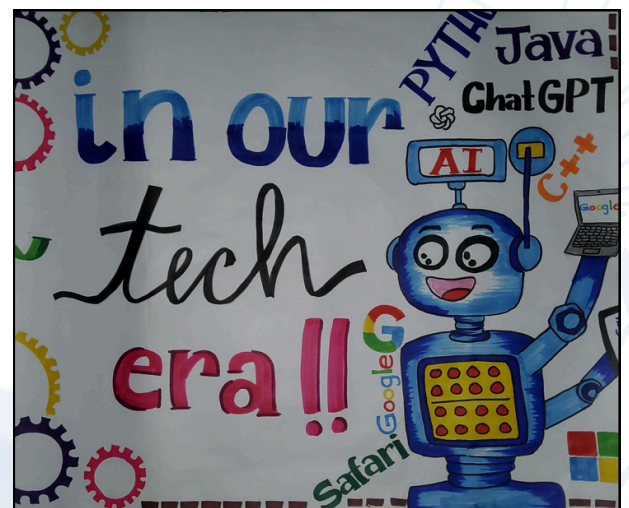
