Each class group showcased the contributions of eminent scientists from their assigned state clusters –

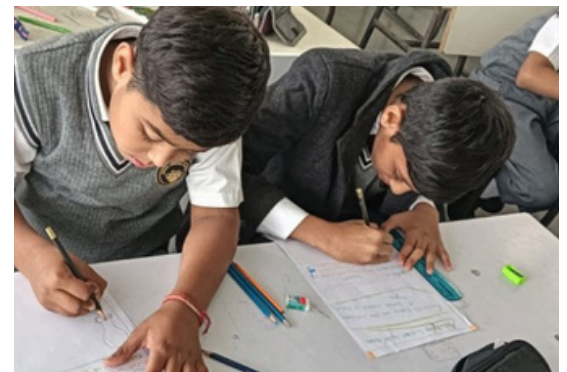

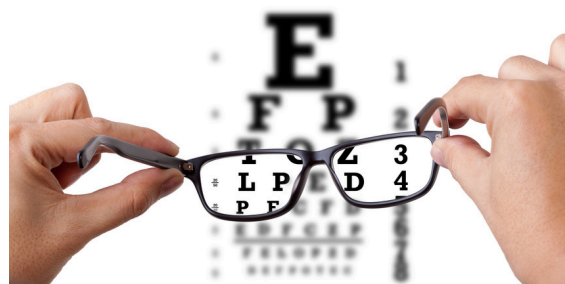

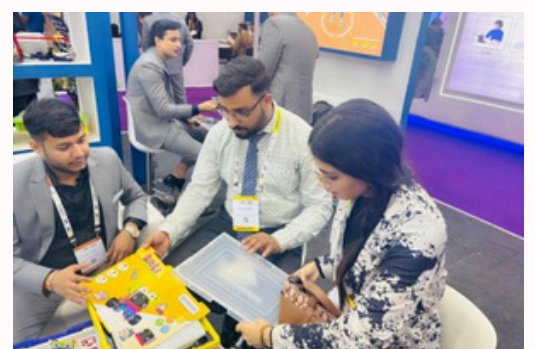

## **CBSE Science Exhibition 2025** ***Innovative Ideas in Action: SISJ*** **Showcases Sensor-Based Automation**



Sehwag International School proudly participated in the CBSE Science Exhibition, where Navyansh (Class XI-A) presented an impressive and innovative project titled “Automation of Street Light Using Sensor Technology.” The project was guided and supervised by Mr. Natesh Kumar, HOD Science.

The functional model utilized Light Dependent Resistors (LDRs) and a microcontroller-based relay system to automate street lighting based on surrounding light levels. This solution highlighted the importance of energy efficiency, sustainability, and real-world applicability in the field of smart infrastructure.

Navyansh confidently explained the concept, working mechanism, and future enhancements such as IoT integration and motion detection to further optimize street lighting in public spaces.

The judges appreciated the project for its clarity, innovation, and scientific relevance. The exhibit complied with all CBSE guidelines and received encouraging feedback for its practical value and thoughtful design.

### ✦ Innovative Project Highlights

The working model effectively demonstrated:

- Automatic switching of street lights based on ambient light
- Energy-efficient operation that reduces unnecessary power usage
- Practical application in both rural and urban environments
- A well-designed display with a clear project chart and explanation sheet

The exhibition experience provided valuable hands-on learning in automation, sensor technology, and STEM-based innovation, further inspiring scientific curiosity and problem-solving skills.
