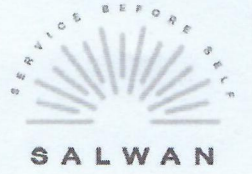

With reference to the queries received from parents, the school would like to clarify that the two recent circulars shared regarding the CBSE language policy for Classes IX–X (session 2026–27 onwards) are based on separate updates issued by CBSE at different stages.

CBSE released the Secondary School Curriculum (Part I) for Classes IX–X (session 2026–2027) on 02 April 2026, wherein only two languages were included in the curriculum as R1 and R2 levels. Accordingly, the school informed parents through a webinar conducted on 25.05.2026, followed by a message that English would be offered as R1 and Hindi/Sanskrit as R2 languages.

Subsequently, CBSE issued another circular, No. CBSE/Acad/SoS/2026, Acad-33/2026 dated 15.05.2026, after reviewing the new NCERT syllabus. As per the revised guidelines, students of Class IX are now required to study three languages — R1, R2, and R3. Therefore, the school shared the updated circular with parents on 19.05.2026 to align with the latest CBSE guidelines.

Please note that the revised three-language scheme is presently applicable only for students of Class IX for the academic session 2026–27, as per the latest CBSE guidelines.

As per the current CBSE policy applicable from 01 July 2026, the mandatory language structure in the school will be as follows:

- R1 – English
- R2 – Hindi
- R3 – Sanskrit

Please note:

- R3 (Sanskrit) will be school-based and internally assessed only.
- There will be no separate CBSE Board Examination for R3 in Class X.
- The performance in R3 will, however, be reflected in the CBSE certificate.

The school is continuously following the latest instructions issued by CBSE and will keep parents informed regarding any further updates or implementation guidelines.
