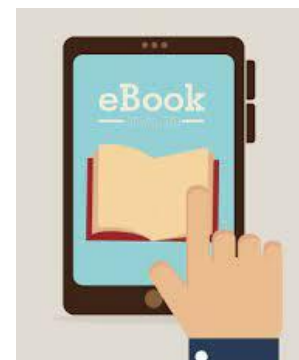

5. Anything in the story that touched you or you found interesting/funny/exciting/scary.

A beautiful handwriting creates a good impression. Practice ONE page of English and ONE page of Hindi handwriting on alternate days for five days, in the Co- Curricular single-lined notebook. Page 4: Findings and Calculations:

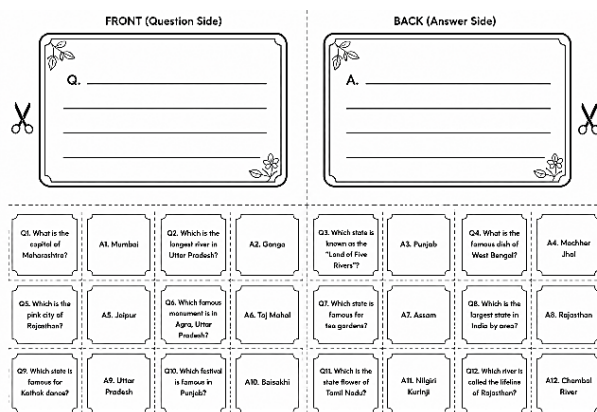
Write and solve:
