MID DAY MEAL

The mid-day meal is prepared under hygienic conditions in the school canteen. The aim is to provide nutritious, well-balanced and delicious food. There is a concerted effort to assist and guide children in developing good dietary habits. The mid-day meal subscription can be availed by depositing the fee in the school canteen on a monthly basis.

NEWSPAPER SUBSCRIPTION

The school encourages students to develop the habit of reading newspapers regularly to enhance their general awareness, language skills, and knowledge of current affairs. To promote this practice, a 15-minute newspaper reading session is conducted daily before the lunch break. The newspaper subscription is available at a nominal cost of ₹385/- for seven months. The subscription can be availed by making the payment through the EduNext App.

TIMETABLE, BOOKS AND STATIONERY

- Kindly send books and notebooks as per the time table.
- Items to be carried in the school bag should include lunch, fruits, water bottle, pencil box, rough notebook and books as per the timetable.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

- It is imperative for students to come to school in a clean and ironed summer school uniform and well-polished school shoes. Students should come well-groomed, with neatly combed hair and properly trimmed nails.
- Students must wear shoes as per the approved design shared earlier. For any clarification, you may refer the school website.
- Sports shoes are permitted only during morning Physical Education coaching.
- Children must wear the school uniform even on their birthdays.
- Wearing the school I-Card every day is mandatory and considered an essential part of the

uniform.

- Girls must wear skin colour cycling shorts under their skirt, if required.

GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS

- Kindly send one seasonal fruit every day for better nutrition and energy.
- Encourage your ward to imbibe civic sense by maintaining cleanliness, following rules and showing respect towards others and public property.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

- In case of absence from school, a leave application addressed to the Class Teacher to be sent either through an email or on an A-4 size sheet or EduNext.
- Students are required to be regular in attending school.
- Medical leave will be granted upon submission of a Medical Certificate on the day Child joins the school.
- No short leaves are allowed. In case a child is unwell, kindly do not send him/her to school.
- Late Arrivals- After three late arrivals to the school, the child will be sent back home on the fourth late arrival and will not be given attendance.

VISITING HOURS FOR PARENTS AND GUARDIANS

Parents may meet the concerned teacher after having sought prior appointment. An appointment should be scheduled through email at spsmayurvihar@salwanschools.com. You are requested to wait at the reception, where the concerned teacher will come and meet. Going directly to the classes to meet the teacher(s) is not allowed.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

- School time is from 08:00 a.m. to 02:00 p.m. You are requested to ensure the punctuality of your ward to school. Children travelling under their own arrangements must reach school before 07:55 a.m. School gates will not open before 07:42 a.m. and will close at 07:56 a.m.
- Parents who pick/drop off their children should park their vehicles responsibly away from the school gates. Two-wheeler riders (including pillion riders) must wear a helmet for safety.
- Parents of on footers, are requested to leave their child at the gate. Parents are not allowed to meet students during school hours. Also, avoid sending any material to school during working hours.
- In the afternoon, buses will leave school at 02:10 p.m. Parents / Guardians / Van Drivers of children commuting under their own arrangements must reach school at 01:55 p.m. for dispersal.
- Gates will open at 02.05 p.m.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Mobile Phones/Electronic Gadgets: Carrying mobile phones or any other electronic gadgets to school is prohibited. If a student brings a mobile phone due to unavoidable circumstances, it must be deposited at the Reception immediately upon arrival. Such devices must not be used anywhere on the school premises or in the school buses. Any mobile phone or electronic gadget found in a student's possession or being used, will be confiscated.
- Students are not permitted to wear any kind of jewellery or accessories to school. Items such as bangles, chains, lockets, dangling earrings and ear studs (for boys), metal bracelets or any accessories worn around the neck, hands, or wrists are prohibited.

- Campus Language/Behaviour- Students should restrain from using unparliamentary language/violence/ unfair means in any form in the school Campus. The students must respect their elders and be courteous to all. No shouting or whistling is allowed in or around the school building.
- Bullying is a punishable offence.
- Students must always converse in English.
- Social media- The students must avoid using social media to post anything against the school, any staff member or stakeholders. This will lead to disciplinary action/ suspension from the school.
- Tobacco- The school is a Tobacco Free Zone and sale of Tobacco within 100 yards from the school premises is prohibited.
- Damage/Breakage- Damage or breakage done even accidentally should be reported to the Class Teacher. The students will be required to pay for any damage to school property. The school reserves the right to suspend/expel students whose conduct is harmful to other students or to the school.
- Weapons- As a safety measure, students are not allowed to bring any weapon or sharp instruments, such as cutter, scissor, blades, knives and paper-scalpels to school.
- Books/Magazines- No irrelevant books (other than textbooks or library books), magazines or other publications may be brought to the school without the class teacher's permission.
- Lending/Borrowing- Lending or borrowing of money or other articles in school is not permitted.
- Self-Driven Vehicles- No student shall bring personal vehicles like scooty/moped in the school premises. If a student is found using the same, it will be confiscated.
- Polybags- The school is committed to protecting the environment and expects its students to be environmentally friendly in all their actions. The use of polybags (plastic bags) is strictly prohibited in the school and students should consciously avoid its use for any purpose.

PAYMENT OF FEE

1. Payment can be made online, preferably through EduNext Parent App.
2. Payment can also be made through Cheque/NEFT/RTGS. The cheque should be drawn in favour of Salwan Public School. Cash payments will not be accepted.
3. Fees paid by cheque should be deposited at the School Accounts Office between 09:00 a.m. and 03:00 p.m. on all working days.
4. If the cheque is dishonoured, charges as applicable will be charged along with the late fee fine.
5. The fees should be paid quarterly. However, parents desirous of paying fees monthly may do so.
6. The schedule for payment of the fee is as follows:

LATE FEE FINE POLICY

a) Payment of fees (on monthly/quarterly basis): By the 10th of the month (if 10th day happens to be a Sunday/holiday, then the next working day). Cheques deposited by 10th of the month, will be considered as fees paid in time, provided the cheque is not dishonoured.

b) Late Fee fine:

- Late fine of Rs. 250/- will be levied if the payment is made between 11th and 20th of the month.
- Late fine of Rs. 750/- will be levied if the payment is made between 21st and the last working day of the month.
- Thereafter, Under Rule 167 of DSER'1973, a show cause notice will be served to parents as to why the name of his/her ward should not be struck off the rolls for non-payment of fees on time.
- Late Fee fine shall also be applicable to all students availing Transport facility but not paying Transport fees by 10th of the month/quarter.
- The cheque deposited but getting dishonoured shall constitute late payment of fee and shall be subject to Late Fee Fine as per the above policy, besides recovery of cheque dishonour charges levied by Bank.

The school needs minimum one-month prior information for the processing of Transfer Certificate (TC). Once the TC is issued, the child will be considered as a fresh applicant for re-admission in case of cancellation. All the dues till the date of issuance of TC must be cleared (including transport fee, if applicable).

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Every student must carry his/her Almanac to school every day.
- Child should mandatorily carry Almanac during his/her visit to the School Infirmary.
- Kindly check EduNext app on regular basis to stay updated on classwork, homework and important messages.
- The school follows a system of fruit break and water break. Please ensure your child carries one fruit daily.
- On birthdays, only chocolates/sweets worth up to ₹30 per child may be sent for distribution.
- Children must not carry sharp objects, cash, or expensive items to school.
- Any change of address/telephone number/e-mail must be informed to the Class Teacher immediately, along with address proof, using the official communication channel.
