IMPORTANT EXAM GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS

As the examination period approaches, we request parents to keep the following points in mind to support their children in their studies::

- Create a Supportive Environment: Ensure your child has a quiet, well-lit place to study without distractions like TV or mobile noise.
- Encourage Healthy Routines: Provide balanced meals, proper hydration and ensure they get 7–8 hours of sleep daily.
- Avoid Pressure & Comparisons: Motivate your child with positivity. Avoid comparing them with siblings or peers, as it adds stress.
- Be Involved, Not Overbearing: Help in planning a timetable, monitor progress gently and be available for doubts without micromanaging.
- Encourage Short Breaks: Remind them to take 5–10-minute breaks after 40–50 minutes of study to refresh the mind.
- Stay Calm & Positive: Your attitude reflects on your child. Stay relaxed, encourage confidence and avoid talking about failure.
- Support During Exam Days: Ensure your child reaches the school on time with all required materials and give them a cheerful send-off.

IMPORTANT EXAM TIPS FOR STUDENTS

As the examination period approaches, please keep the following points in mind for effective preparation:

- Create a Study Schedule: Plan your study time effectively, allocating more time to subjects you find challenging.
- Stay Organised: Keep your notes, textbooks, and study materials well-organised for easy access.

- Practice Sample Papers: Familiarise yourself with the exam format and types of questions by practicing sample papers.

- Stay Positive: Maintain a positive attitude and believe in your abilities.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE DURING EXAMINATION

In case a child is unwell, kindly do not send them to school and please inform the Class Teacher. A retest will be conducted for absence on medical grounds only. It is mandatory to submit a valid Medical Certificate within three working days of the child's absence.

MID DAY MEAL

The mid-day meal is prepared under hygienic conditions in the school canteen. The aim is to provide nutritious, well-balanced and delicious food. There is a concerted effort to assist and guide children in developing good dietary habits. The mid-day meal subscription can be availed by depositing the fee in the school canteen on a monthly basis.

PAYMENT OF FEE

1. Payment can be made online, preferably through EduNext Parent App.
2. Payment can also be made through Cheque/NEFT/RTGS. The cheque should be drawn in favour of Salwan Public School. Cash payments will not be accepted.

3. Fees paid by cheque should be deposited at the School Accounts Office between 09:00 a.m. and 03:00 p.m. on all working days.
4. If the cheque is dishonoured, charges as applicable will be charged along with the late fee.
5. The fees should be paid quarterly. However, parents desirous of paying fees monthly may do so.
6. The schedule for payment of the fee is as follows:

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Every student must carry his/her old Almanac to school every day.
- It is imperative for students to come to school in a clean and ironed school uniform and well-polished school shoes.
- Students must wear their I-Cards to school every day.
- Kindly check EduNext app on a regular basis to stay updated on classwork, homework and important messages.
- The school follows a system of fruit and water break. Please ensure your child carries one fruit daily.
- On birthdays, only chocolates/sweets worth up to ₹30 per child may be sent for distribution.
- Children must not carry sharp objects, cash, or expensive items to school.
- Any change of address/telephone number/e-mail must be informed to the Class Teacher immediately, along with address proof, using the official communication channel.
- Mobile Phones/Electronic Gadgets: Carrying mobile phones or any other electronic gadgets to school is prohibited. If a student brings a mobile phone due to unavoidable circumstances, it must be deposited at the reception immediately upon arrival. Such devices must not be used anywhere on the school premises or in the school buses. Any mobile phone or electronic gadget found in a student's possession or being used, will be confiscated.
