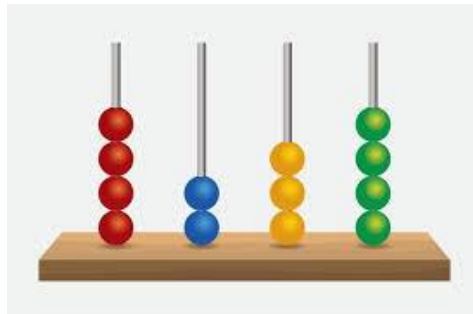
ACTIVITY 1 - ADVENTURE INTO WORLD OF WORDS

ACTIVITY 2 - COUNT THE YEARS MOVE THE BEADS

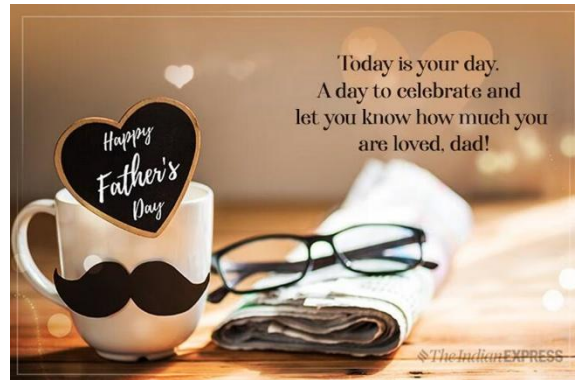
- Ask the ages of your family members and write them neatly in your Mathematics notebook.
