PROJECT STRUCTURE

1. Cover Page (Art Integration)

- Title: **“Imagination Station: Arunachal Pradesh”**
- Decorate with drawings of **mountains, jewellery, festivals, and culture**



2. About Arunachal Pradesh (English + Hindi + Computer)

- Write:
 - **5–6 facts in English** (typed/handwritten, creatively formatted)
 - **8–10 lines in Hindi** (अनुच्छेद)
- Include **2–3 keywords with meanings** (शब्दार्थ)

3. Culture & Traditions (English + Art + Music)

- Paste/draw a Tribal dress or festival (Losar) and a dancer or musical instrument
- Write 4–5 sentences on the musical culture of Arunachal Pradesh and 3 lines on the importance of music

4. Jewellery & Craft (Art + EVS)

- Draw/paste traditional jewellery
- Create a **small model using waste materials**
- Write 3–4 lines on materials used (beads, bamboo, etc.)

5. Maths in Mountains (Maths + Art)

- Draw a **mountain scene**
- Assume 3 heights (e.g., 3000 m, 4500 m, 5200 m):
 - Arrange in **ascending & descending order**
 - Find the **difference**
 - Write **number names**

6. Tourism & Transport (Social Science + English)

- Design a **bookmark** showing Arunachal Pradesh
- Write:
 - 4–5 lines on tourism
 - 2–3 lines on transport
 - A slogan: “Visit Arunachal Pradesh”

7. Map Work (G.K.)

- Draw and label map showing:
 - Capital: **Itanagar**
 - Rivers: **Siang, Subansiri**
 - Neighbours: **China, Bhutan, Myanmar**

8. Environment & Values (Science + Value Education)

- Make an **eco-poster** on protecting forests/ivers
- Draw a scene of **helping people or nature**
- Write 2 values learned (e.g., care for nature, unity)

9. Creative Add-On (Art & Craft)

- Make a **photo frame (A4 size)**
- Draw your portrait and paste it inside
