#### Colours of Arunachal Pradesh — My Heritage Bag

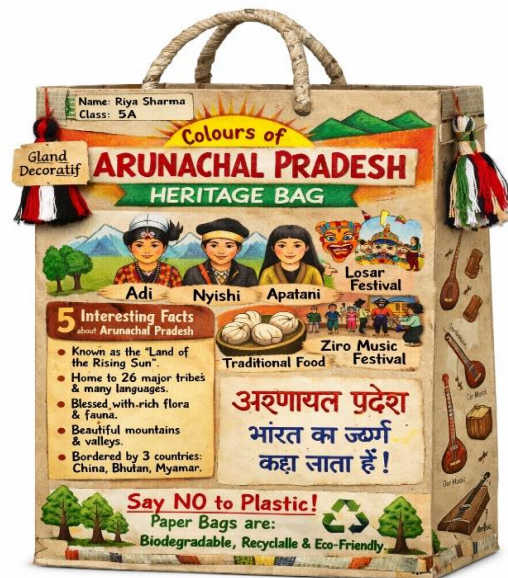
**OBJECTIVE:** To explore the rich culture, environment, and traditions of Arunachal Pradesh through a hands-on creative bag-making project by integrating learning across subjects.

#### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Use **only recycled materials** (chart paper/newspaper)
- Write **Name, Class & Section** clearly on the bag
- All work must be in **your own handwriting**
- Keep the bag **strong, neat, and creative**
- The homework must be submitted **on or before 06.07.2026**



#### PROJECT TASK (ALL SUBJECTS IN ONE BAG)

##### 1. Bag Making (Art + Science)

- Create a **sturdy paper bag** (Size: 60 cm × 30 cm × 16 cm)
- Use **eco-friendly materials only**
- Inside the bag, write **3–4 lines** on why paper bags are better than plastic (biodegradable, recyclable, eco-friendly)

##### 2. Maths Connection

- Calculate the **total surface area of the bag**
- Show the complete work neatly on a **separate sheet** and attach it inside

##### 3. Language Expression (English + Hindi + French)

**English:**

- Write **5 interesting facts about Arunachal Pradesh** (on one side of bag)

**Hindi:**

- Write a **slogan/quotation** about Arunachal Pradesh (on another side)

**French:**

- Create a **decorative tassel** for the bag and label it in French (e.g., "Gland Décoratif")

- On the **front of the bag**, draw/paste:
  - Tribal groups (Adi, Nyishi, Apatani)
  - Festivals (Losar, Ziro Music Festival)
  - Traditional food

## 5. Music Integration (Attach A4 Sheets Inside the Bag)

- Paste pictures of **5 Indian Classical Singers** (male/female)
- Draw **6 musical instruments** neatly
- Learn:
  - The **School Anthem** and **National Anthem** given on Page Nos. 14 and 13 of the School Almanac respectively.
